has complied with the terms and conditions of the permit, issued pursuant to Application for Permit dated June 29, 1983; and has submitted Proof of Beneficial Use on October 22, 1990. An examination indicates that the works have a diversion capacity of 0.890 cfs of water from a **GROUNDWATER** source, and a water right has been established as follows:

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL AND REMARKS

1. The maximum diversion volume is defined as the maximum allowable volume of water that may be diverted annually from the source under this right. The use of water confirmed by this right is limited to the amount which can actually be beneficially used. The maximum diversion volume may be adjusted to more accurately describe the beneficial use or to implement accepted standards of diversion and use efficiency.
2. This water right is appurtenant to the described place of use.

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CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL AND REMARKS

3. This right is subject to all prior water rights and may be forfeited by five years of non-use.
4. Modifications to or variance from this license must be made within the limits of Section 42-222, Idaho Code, or the applicable Idaho law.
5. Water used under this right when discharged into a natural channel or subsurface system shall meet Idaho Water Quality Standards.
6. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than .03 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre for the lands above.
7. Two points of diversion are located within NENW, S32, T08S, R16E.
8. Rights 36-15162 and 36-08350 are also diverted through the points of diversion described above.
9. Commercial use is for a dairy.
