Dear Mr. Blass:

The department of Water Resources (DWR) is currently reviewing protested applications for permit which are pending before the department. Our files show that the above referenced application was filed on June 4, 1980 proposing the diversion of 6 cubic feet per second (cfs) of water from Seepage tributary to LS-2 Coulee to be used year round for fish propagation purposes. The application was subsequently protested by The Twin Falls Canal Company.

Since substantial time has passed after the filing of the application, the department requests certain information in order to resolve the matter of the pending protested application. It appears that one of two potential actions needs to occur in connection with the application as follows:

- 1. If you are no longer interested in pursuing the development proposed in the application, please complete and return the enclosed relinquishment form. The application will then be removed from DWR records.
- 2. If you are interested in pursing the proposed development you need to specifically advise the department in writing of your continued interest within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter. In addition, you must provide the information described below to the department within sixty (60) days of the date of this letter.
 - Copies of deeds, leases or other information to document that you have a possessory interest in the place of use. (Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,3,3,1.).
 - Copies of plans and specifications along with estimated construction costs for the project works. The plans must be definite enough to allow for the determination of project impacts and implications. The plans must show the number of ponds proposed and give the length, width and depth dimensions of all ponds. (Water

- A certified financial statement or a financial commitment letter along with the financial statement of the lender or other evidence to show that it is reasonably probable that financing will be available to appropriate the water and apply it to beneficial use. (Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,3,4,1.).
- You must seek comment on the effects of the construction and operation of the proposed project from the city and/or county within which the project is to be located and from the Idaho Department of Fish and Game. In addition you must obtain certification from the Idaho department of Health and Welfare, Division of Environment that operation of your project will meet state water quality standards before IDWR will issue a permit. (Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,3,5,1.).
- If the source of water has five (5) or fewer existing users, you must provide a list of the number of impacted rights, the names and addresses of the users, locations of the points of diversion, and the nature of use of the existing rights. (Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,3,1,1.).
- A statement of design, construction or operation techniques which will be used to reduce impact on existing rights. (Water Appropriation Rule 4,5,3,1,3.).

If you do not timely respond to this letter, the department will reject the application as being filed for speculative purposes. If you do timely respond and provide the required information, the department will schedule a hearing if appropriate. Feel free to contact this office or our Southern Regional Office in Twin Falls if you have questions.


