Dear Mr. Cannon:

The department of Water Resources (DWR) is currently reviewing protested applications for permit which are pending before the department. Our files show that the above referenced application was filed on February 25, 1980 proposing the diversion of 2.0 cubic feet per second (cfs) of water from an Unnamed Spring via Lateral 44 and 44A in Twin Falls County to be used year round for recreation and livestock purposes. The application was subsequently protested by The Twin Falls Canal Company.

Since substantial time has passed after the filing of the application, the department requests that you advise us of your continued interest in the protested application before we schedule a hearing in the matter. It appears that one of two potential actions needs to occur in connection with the application as follows:

1. If you are no longer interested in pursuing the development proposed in the application, please complete and return the enclosed relinquishment form. The application will then be removed from DWR records.
2. If you are interested in pursuing the proposed development you need to specifically advise the department in writing of your continued interest within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter. In addition, you must advise the department of potential hearing dates which are acceptable to you during the next several months.

If you do not timely respond to this letter, the department will reject the application as being filed for speculative purposes. If you do timely respond and provide the required information, the department will schedule a hearing if appropriate.

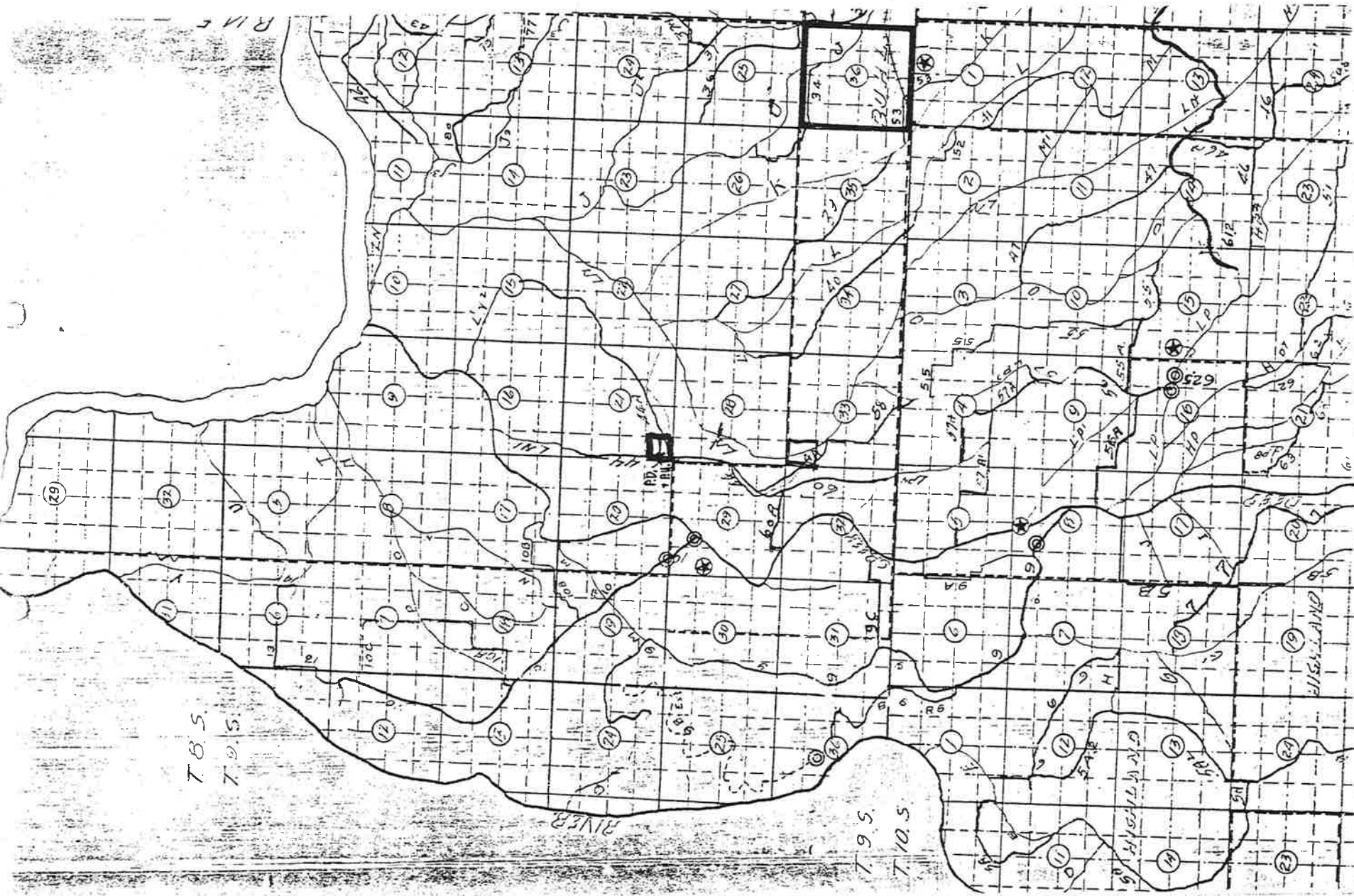
