

Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or be fore September 1 , 19 85 .  c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.  d. Other: (1) Measuring devices of a type approved by the Department shall be permanently installed and maintained at the point of diversion and the point of effluent discharge. (2) Use of water under this permit is subject to control by the watermaster of State Water District # 47-0, Rock Creek. (3) The permit shall not be assigned or sold without first securing the written approval of the Department of Water Resources.
