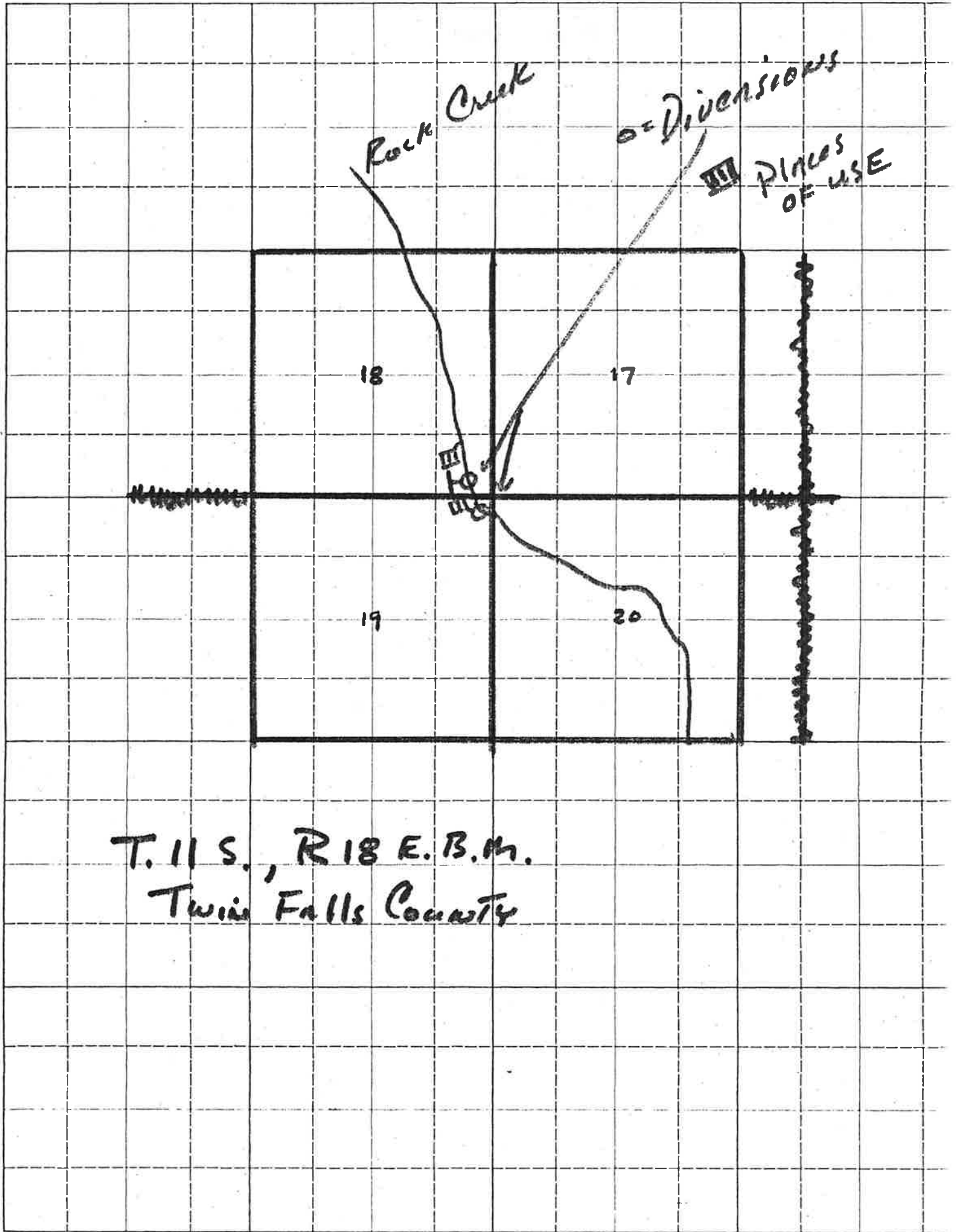

ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-7609, and said application is hereby approved.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.
- b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before September 1, 19 85.
- c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
- d. Other: (1) Measuring devices of a type approved by the Department shall be permanently installed and maintained at the point of diversion and the point of effluent discharge. (2) Use of water under this permit is subject to control by the watermaster of State Water District # 47-0, Rock Creek. (3) The permit shall not be assigned or sold without first securing the written approval of the Department of Water Resources. (4) Water used under this permit if discharged into a natural channel shall meet Idaho Water Quality Standards.
