#### Narrative for Application for Temporary Approval of Water Use


Bogus Basin Recreational Association (Bogus) is applying for a temporary water right to promote and establish root growth of plant species below the recently constructed snowmaking pond. Establishing plantings will help stabilize this area and reduce sediment load into Bogus Creek.

In order to accomplish this, Bogus will divert ground water from an existing well at the ski area, on Bogus' private property. The point of diversion for the well is located in Township 5N, Range 3E, Section 16, SWNE. The ground water will be conveyed through an existing system of pipes where it will be discharged into the snowmaking pond, located in Township 5N, Range 3E, Section 16, SWSW. The ground water will then be pumped from the pond by a portable pump for irrigation of a portion of the 3.67 acre place of use adjacent to the snowmaking pond as depicted in the detailed drawing attached to this narrative. A temporary, irrigation system will be installed to accomplish this purpose.

The highest priority stabilization areas within the proposed place of use total approximately 3.0 acres. Based on a conservative estimated maximum evapotranspiration rate of 5 inches per month at the site and a total of 100 irrigation days, the total volume pumped under this application is anticipated to be 4.2 acre-feet, and in no way will exceed 5.0 acre-feet

The below screenshot, taken from IDWR's Water Right Locator mapping tool, shows the point of diversion in SESE and the place of use in SWSW. The attached drawing shows how the water will be conveyed from the point of diversion to the place of use, with more detail for place of use.
