On November 7, 1980, I inspected the P/U 47-7528 with the current owner of the property, Larry Holland. (Mr. Holland is also applicant on 47-7659).

Since my last visit to the place, which was to do a pre-permit exam on 47-7528, water has been diverted from Slaughterhouse Gulch into an existing ditch and now flows through a small pond before returning to Rock Creek. The pond is not built for the raising of trout and no fish were present at the time.

There has been a considerable amount of remodeling done on the property, but other than diversion of water into the ditch and construction of the pond, no changes in water use on the place.

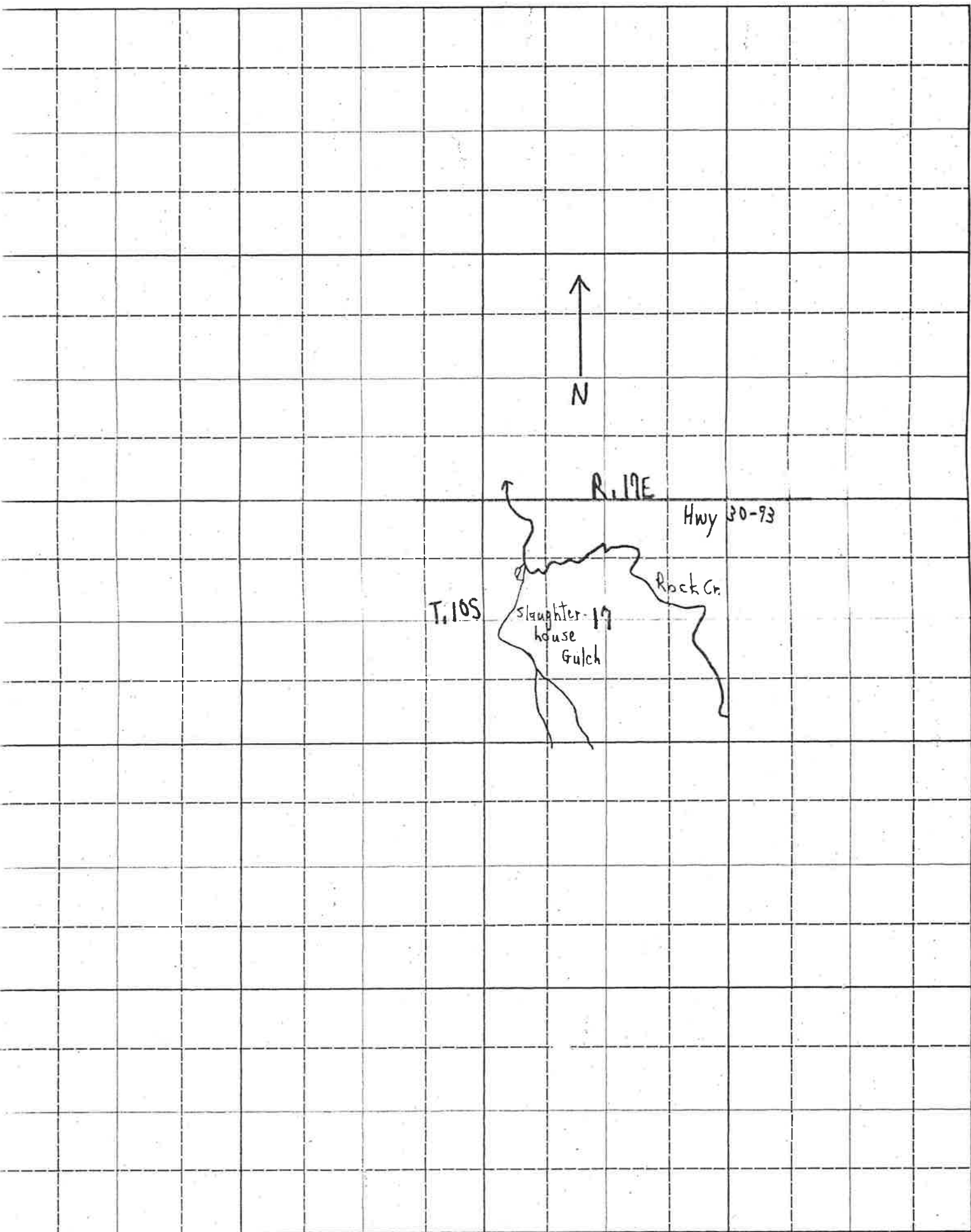

ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-7258, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.
- b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before August 1, 19 84.
- c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
- d. Other: ~~(1) Measuring devices of a type approved by the Department shall be permanently installed and maintained at the point of diversion and the point of effluent discharge. (2) The issuance of this permit in no way grants any right-of-way or easement across the land of another. (3) This permit shall not be assigned or sold without first securing the written approval of the Department of Water Resources. (4) Return water shall be treated to insure that the effluent meets intrastate stream water quality standards.~~
