ORDER

WHEREAS, on November 8, 1978, the U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management applied to the Department of Water Resources for a permit to appropriate 0.00892 cubic feet per second of water from Peony Spring to be diverted within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 16, Twp. 16S, Rge. 16E B.M., Twin Falls County, to be used for livestock purposes; and,

WHEREAS, on January 11, 1979, the Department approved said application and issued Permit No. 47-7498 with the condition that proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use be submitted on or before February 1, 1980; and,

WHEREAS, on December 7, 1979, the permit holder submitted a request for an extension of time; and,

WHEREAS, it appears that under the circumstances, the permit holder has been proceeding with reasonable diligence and has given good cause for delay;

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which to submit proof of beneficial use of water under Permit No. 47-7498 be extended to February 1, 1983.

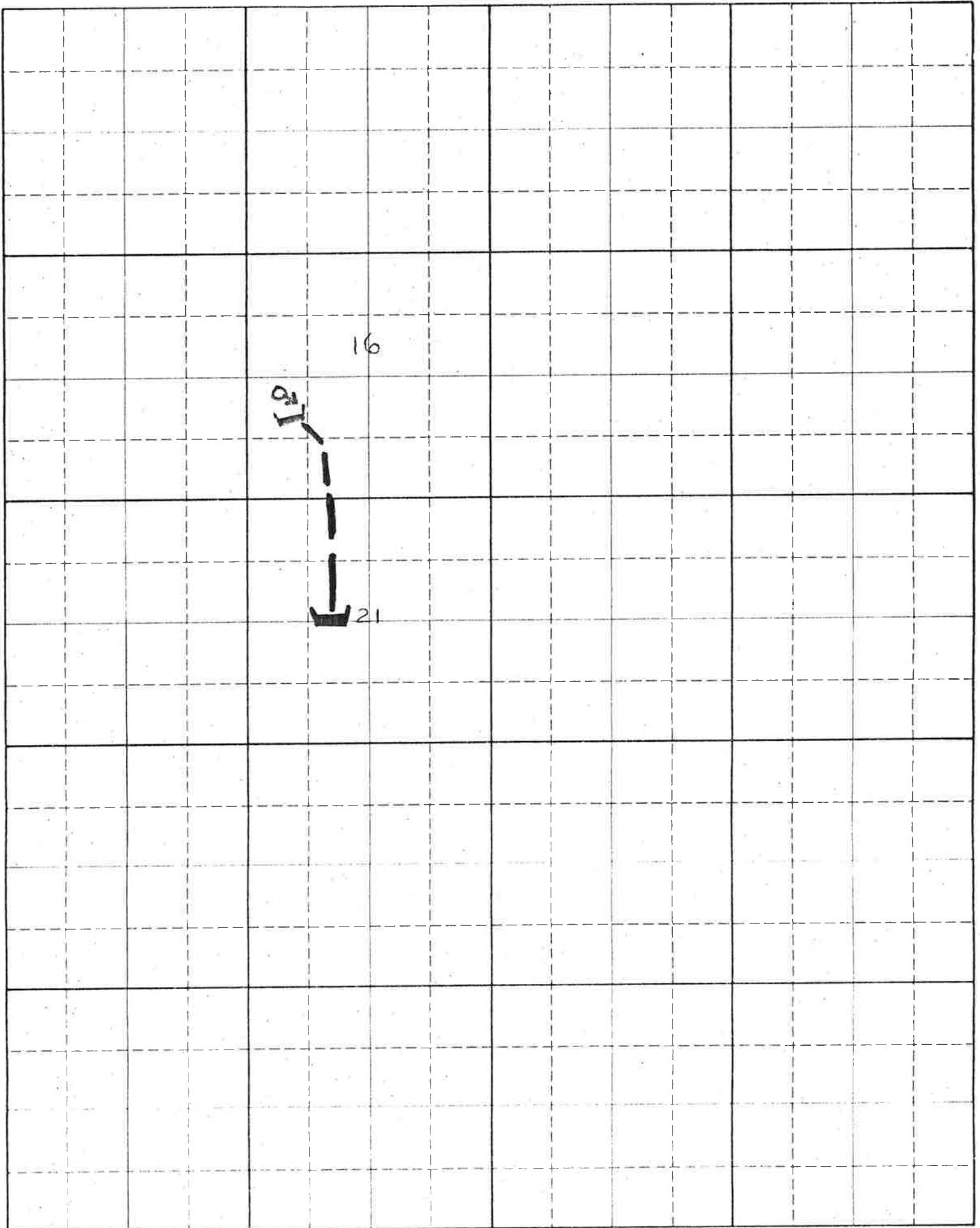
