ORDER DENYING
PERMIT

WHEREAS, on June 17, 1977, Donald Jewett applied to the Department of Water Resources for a permit to appropriate 4.00 cubic feet per second of water from a groundwater source to be diverted from a point within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 5, Twp. 16S, Rge. 27E, B.M., Cassia County, to be used for stockwater and domestic purposes and the irrigation of 245.28 acres of land within Sec. 5, Twp. 16S, Rge. 27E, B.M., Cassia County; and,

WHEREAS, the Department caused notice of the application to be published in the South Idaho Press at Burley, Idaho, on June 28, and July 5, 1977; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Water Resources pursuant to 42-233a, Idaho Code, established the Raft River Critical Ground Water Area; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department, having reviewed the application, finds that the proposed point of diversion is located within the Raft River Critical Ground Water Area boundaries as modified by the Order of November 3, 1970; and,

WHEREAS, the information on file with the Director shows that the reasonably anticipated average rate of future natural recharge is substantially less than the current rate of withdrawal of ground water within the Raft River Critical Ground Water Area, and said information also shows that ground water pumping levels are continuing to decline; and,

WHEREAS, the Director, having studied the application and the area of withdrawal of water, finds that there is no water available for additional appropriation and that any additional appropriation of water will adversely affect the water level and other existing water rights in said area;

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED that Application for Permit No. 47-7407, be and is, DENIED.

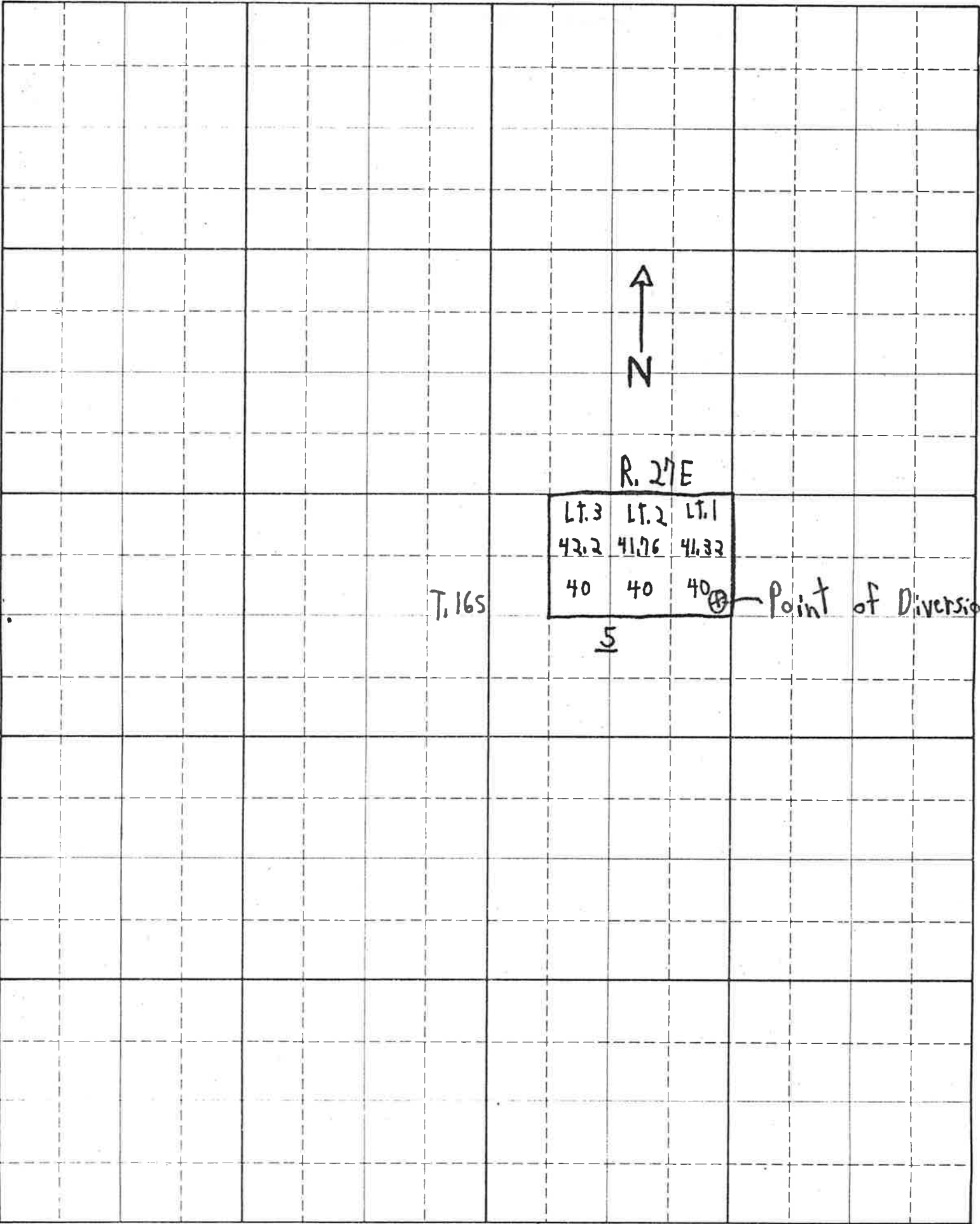
