That under the terms and conditions of said permit, work thereunder was required to be completed on or before

July 1, 1982.

That he has heretofore performed the following work described under said permit: I installed

Right now the farm out back is poor. With the price of copper I decided to postpone drilling for awhile. on 10.00 beans its pretty hard to drill wells now.

Wherefore, he asks that the Department of Water Resources extend the time for the completion of obligations under said permit to 5 year, 1987.

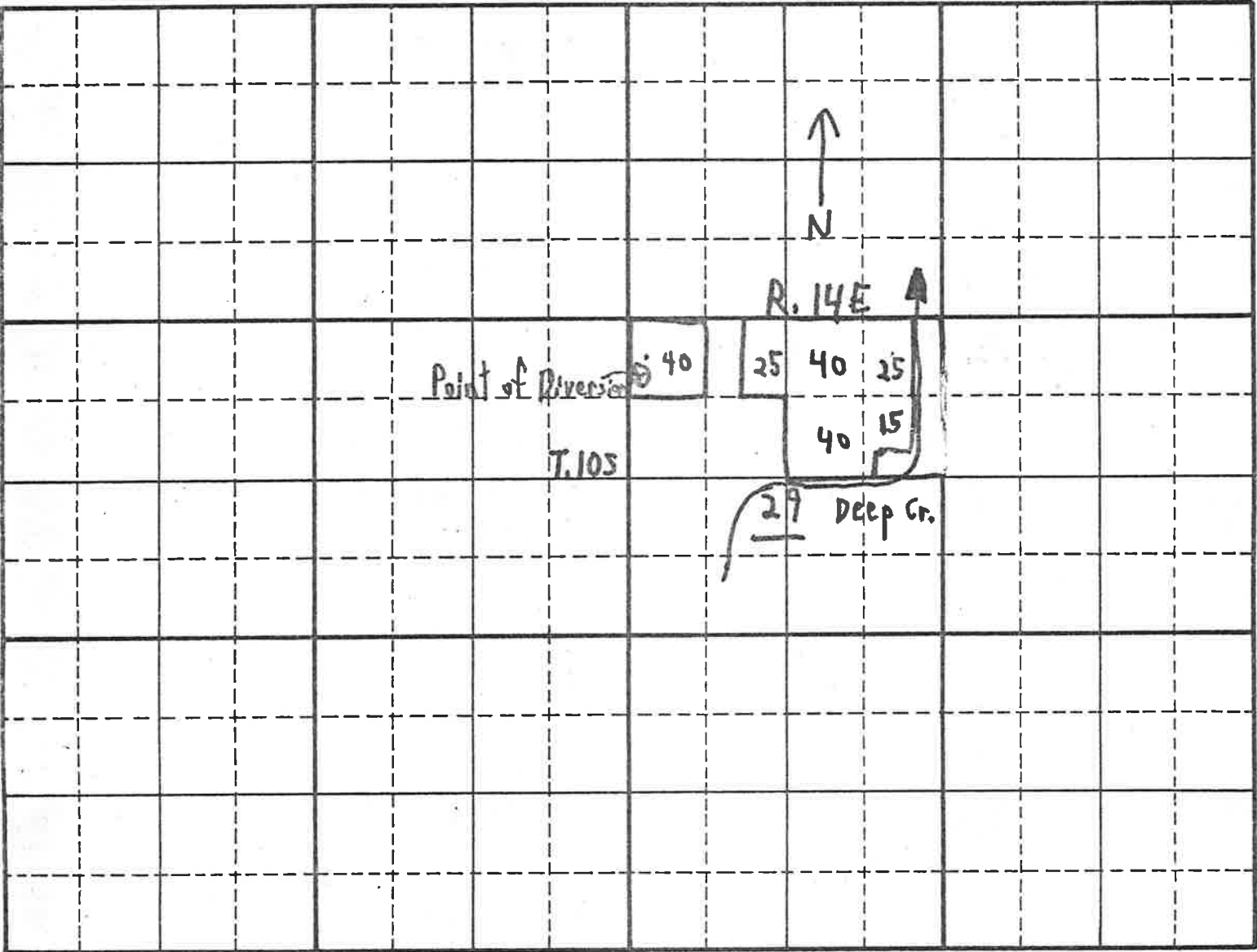

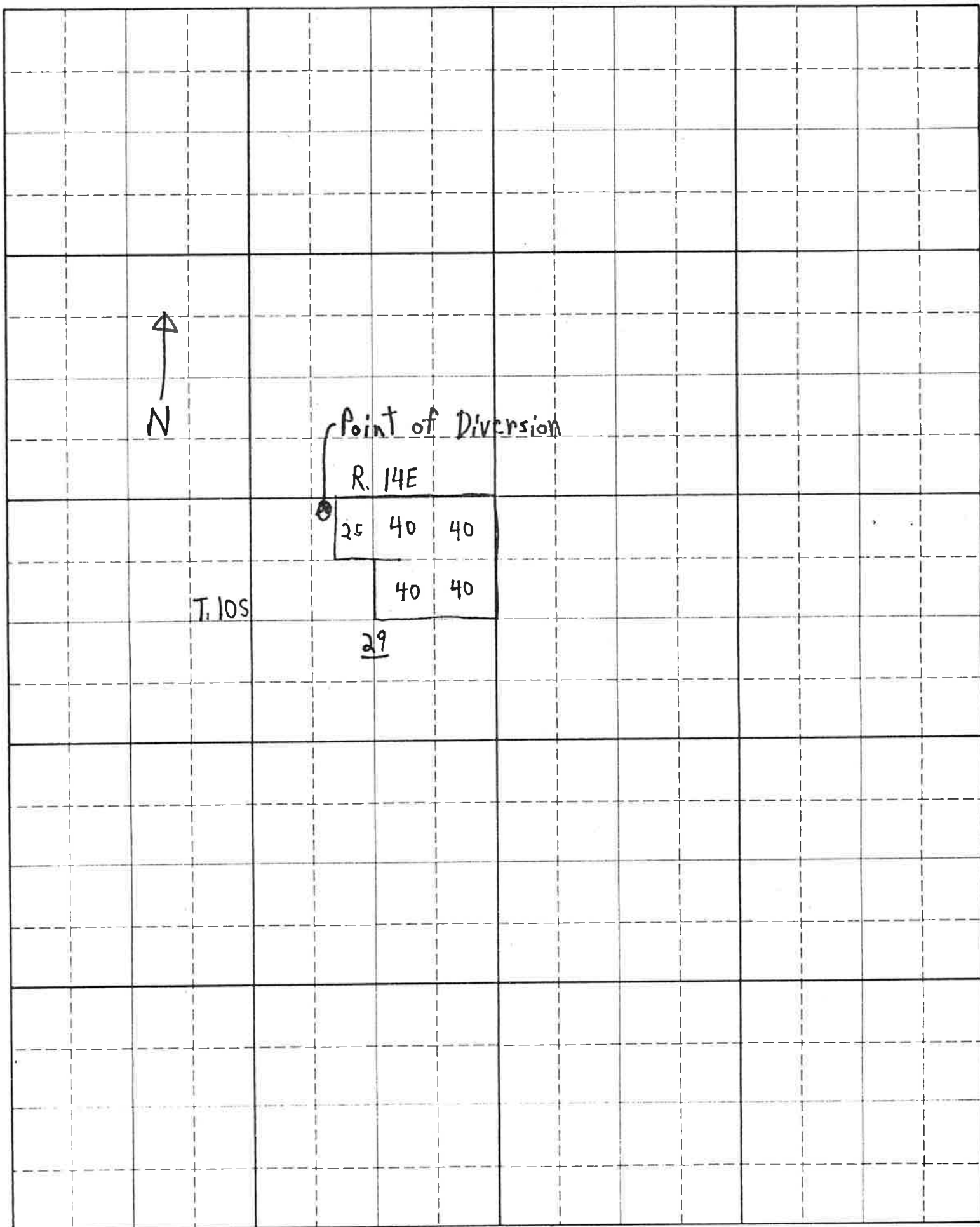

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 47-7395, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

- a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.
- b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before July 1, 19 82.
- c. Other: A measuring device of a type approved by this Department shall be permanently installed and maintained as part of the diverting works.

The rate of diversion of water for irrigation under this permit and all other water rights on the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.
