#### RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- 2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. Rights 36-16237 and 36-8329 are also diverted through the point of diversion described above.
- 10. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1412(6), this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.

- 11. Use of water under this agreement may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 130.
- 12. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the filed headgate for irrigation of the lands above.
- 13. Prior to diversion of water under this right, the right holder shall install a lockable device, subject to the approval of the Department, in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversion.
- 14. When notified by the Department, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works.







#### **IRRIGATION**

## EXCHANGE OF WATER RIGHTS AGREEMENT

This Exchange Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into this 10th day of 1614, 2005, by CLEAR SPRINGS FOODS, INC. ("Clear Springs Foods") that is a party to, beneficiary, or holder of interest in water right 36-02703 and CLEAR LAKE RANCH PUD MASTER ASSOCIATION, INC. ("Clear Lake Ranch") that is a party to, beneficiary, or holder of interest in water right 36-4148 A.

#### **RECITALS:**

- A. Clear Springs Foods holds fish propagation water right 36-2703 dated Nov. 23, 1933 for 40 cubic feet per second (cfs) diverted from Clear Springs.
- B. Clear Lake Ranch holds an irrigation water right 36-04148 A dated Sept. 9, 1912 for 1.5 cfs diverted from Clear Springs of which 0.6 cfs has been sold to Clear Lake Country Club and for which a transfer application (71435) has been received by the Idaho Department of Water Resources dated Aug. 5, 2004.
- C. Clear Lake Ranch holds water right 36-8329 dated June 2, 1987 for 1.5 cfs diverted from Clear Springs of which 1.5 cfs is for fire protection, 0.7 cfs is for domestic residential use and 0.2 cfs is for commercial use.
- D. Clear Springs Foods made a water delivery call May 2, 2005 in which Clear Lake Ranch water right 36-8329 is junior and potentially subject to curtailment.
- E. Clear Springs Foods holds water right 36-07148 dated Jan. 1, 1971 for 1.67 cfs diverted from Clear Springs of which 0.8 cfs was, prior to adjudication, for commercial use but subsequent to adjudication is for fish propagation and domestic use only. Clear Springs Foods irrigates approximately 8 acres of visitor center grounds and shrubbery but does not have a decreed water right for irrigation.
- F. It is to the mutual benefit of the parties hereto that an exchange agreement be formalized that ensures the right of Clear Lakes Ranch to divert water from Clear Springs to satisfy their 0.7 cfs domestic residential use and 0.2 cfs for commercial use and further that the exchange agreement ensure the right of Clear Springs Foods to divert water from Clear Springs to satisfy their need to irrigate approximately 8 acres of visitor center grounds and shrubbery.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual benefits accruing to the parties hereto, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Exchange: Clear Springs Foods hereby subordinates 0.9 cfs of their water right 36-2703 to Clear Lake Ranch for domestic residential and commercial use under water right no. 36-8329, in exchange for Clear Lake Ranch's lease of 0.16 cfs of their water right 36-04148 A to Clear Springs Foods for irrigation use. The parties to this Agreement acknowledge that Clear Springs' subordination identified herein constitutes adequate

consideration and payment for Clear Lakes Ranch's lease of water. Further, the parties agree that upon signing of this Agreement Clear Springs Foods shall submit this Agreement to the Watermaster for Water District 130 for approval in order to avoid administration of Clear Lake Ranch's water right. Clear Lake Ranch shall notify the Watermaster of the lease of 0.16 cfs of water right 36-04148 to Clear Springs Foods and ensure that any necessary submittals are made to the State for approval of the lease. This Agreement and the parties' obligations shall be subject to the above approvals required, if any.

- 2. <u>Term:</u> The term of this Agreement shall continue from year-to-year until both parties agree in writing to terminate said Agreement.
- 3. <u>Counterparts.</u> This Agreement may be executed in counterparts and as executed shall constitute one agreement binding on the parties hereto, even though the parties do not sign the original or the same counterpart.
- 4. Entire Agreement. This Agreement shall be the whole and only agreement with regards to the subordination of water rights held by Clear Springs Foods and lease of water right held by Clear Lake Ranch.
- 5. <u>Idaho Law.</u> This Agreement is governed by Idaho law, irrespective of its choice of law principles.
- 6. **Binding Effect.** This Agreement shall be binding on Clear Springs Foods and Clear Lake Ranch, and their respective heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns.
- 7. <u>Severability; Waivers.</u> If any part of this Agreement is not enforceable, the remainder of the Agreement shall be void.
- 8. <u>Headings.</u> Article and paragraph headings are for reference only and shall not affect the interpretation or meaning of any provision of this Agreement.
- Notices. Any notice, request, tender, demand, delivery, approval or other communication provided for, required, or arising under this Agreement shall be in writing and, unless sooner actually received, shall be deemed delivered three (3) business days after deposit in the United States mail, certified with receipt requested, postage prepaid, and addressed to the party as follows:

#### **MEMORANDUM FOR AGREEMENT # 376**

Re: Review & Analysis of Application to Rent Water from the State Water Supply Bank

**PURPOSE/NARRATIVE:** The Department received a rental application from Clear Springs Foods Inc. (Foods) on December 2, 2019. Foods requests to rent water right 36-16236 for a period of 5 years, through 2024. This rental is a renewal of prior 5 year terms from 2010 to 2014 and 2015 through 2019. The rental application proposes to use right 36-16236 for the irrigation of 8.0 acres of lawn and shrubbery.

On 12/3/19, the Department emailed the applicant informing them that the lease of right 36-16236 will expire at the end of 2020. Therefore, the rental by Foods will be approved only for the 2020 year to agree with the lease.

Another email was sent to the applicant on 12/12/19 requesting a map showing where the rented water would be applied.

Upon further review of the application, it was also unclear where exactly Foods intends to divert the rented water. I emailed the applicant on 12/13/19 requesting clarification to the rental POD. The applicant provided maps clarifying the rental POU as well as the POD by email on 12/13/19.

An exchange agreement between Clear Lake Ranch PUD Master Assn Inc. (Ranch) and Foods was included with the rental application. Through the agreement, both Ranch and Foods exchange portions of their water rights to assist in desired irrigation and domestic needs by both parties. Ranch owns irrigation right 36-16236 and right 36-8329 for fire protection, domestic and commercial use. Meanwhile, Foods owns right 36-2703 for fish propagation. Under the agreement, Ranch leases 0.16 cfs from 36-16236 into the Bank in exchange for Foods offering up 0.9 cfs from right 36-2703 towards right 36-8329.

Rights 36-2703 and 36-8329 are used at different locations for different purposes and their POD's are approximately 67 feet apart. As noted in the previous rental review memo, it is unclear how Ranch is receiving 0.9 cfs from Foods. Even though I could not find any records of a transfer, exchange or lease for this portion of the exchange agreement, it is part of a private agreement between Foods and Ranch. The Department will not pursue matters pertaining to the exchange agreement.

**AUTHORITY TO FILE:** The application was signed by Ty Popplewell. A search of the Idaho Secretary of State website lists Mr. Popplewell as a registered agent for Foods. Irrigation use will occur at common vegetation areas at the rental POU. According to Department records, the rental POU and POD are located on property owned by Foods. There are no concerns about the ownership of the leased right or the property at the rental POU/POD.

**WATER RIGHT VALIDITY:** Water right 36-16236 is used for irrigation by Ranch. In February 2006, transfer # 71435 split right 36-4148A into 36-16236 and 36-16237. Under right 36-16236, 44.7 acres can be irrigated at .9 cfs. Aerial imagery from the last 5 years indicates at least 8 acres within the POU for right 36-16236 has not been irrigated. The lessor appears to be in compliance with their lease. There are no concerns with validity of the requested right to be rented.

**INJURY TO OTHER WATER RIGHTS:** The rental proposes to divert water through the existing POD used by right 36-16236. With no change in the POD location, injury to other water rights should be prevented. The POD is also used by right 36-12637 and 36-8329. Right 36-16237 is owned by Clear Lake Country Club and is used for irrigation of 90 acres. Ownership and use of right 36-8329 is discussed near the beginning of the memo. Injury to other water rights does not seem apparent.

**ENLARGEMENT OF USE:** The rental of water from right 36-16236 has occurred for at least the last 10 years. North Side Canal Co. LTD owns multiple overlapping irrigation rights at the rental POU but these rights are not pertinent to the rental POU. As mentioned above regarding water right validity, within the authorized POU for right 36-16239, there are 8 or more acres that have clearly not been irrigated. There are no concerns with enlargement of right 36-16236.

**LOCAL PUBLIC INTEREST**: Review staff has no information to suggest this application is inconsistent with the local public interest.

**BENEFICIAL USE/CONSERVATION OF WATER RESOURCES:** The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

**DEPARTMENT STAFF OR WATERMASTER COMMENTS:** The location for the rental POD is subject to Water District # 130. Comments were requested from watermaster Nathan Erickson and Southern Region on 12/13/19. The watermaster replied on 12/17/19 with no concerns.



Hi Ty,

The Department of Water Resources received a new rental application (Number 1510) from Clear Springs Foods, for the irrigation of 8 acres, per the ongoing exchange of water rights between Clear Springs Foods and Clear Lake Ranch. Please know, the Clear Lake Ranch lease of water right 36-16236 will expire at the end of 2020. As such, we can only approve rental application 1510 for one year, through 2020, to coincide with the expiration of the water lease.

If Clear Lake Ranch and Clear Springs Foods desire to continue the water right exchange agreement through future Water Supply Bank water right leases and rentals after 2020, then Clear Lake Ranch should submit a new lease application, to lease their water right into the Bank for an additional number of years, to commence in 2021. Once a new lease of water right 36-16236 is accepted into the Water Supply Bank, Clear Springs Foods can request a rental of water right 36-16236 beyond 2020.

No action is required from you at this time, however I wanted to provide you with this explanation as to why we would be presenting Clear Springs Foods with a one year rental, for 2020.
