Dear Mr. Strobel:

Per my conversation with you and Mr. Babin on 11-08-78, I had a meeting with Mr. Bibbes and Ms. Blom on 11-09-78 regarding my wife's desert entry. You will recall that her proposed source of water is the Canyon View Irrigation Company and that you have indicated an extension will not be granted to her with that source of water.

I discussed with them and you an alternate water plan using Salmon Falls Creek water with delivery through a neighbor's existing system. My wife has filed for a water permit on Salmon Falls Creek with the State Water Resources Department (a copy is attached). The matter has been generally agreed upon with the neighbor but it has not been reduced to writing as of this date.

In addition to this water right potential I call your attention to the fact that my wife has an underground water permit #47-7083 which was extended to October 1, 1979. She has made application for a five year extension to that permit (a copy attached). Your file should show that we drilled a 905' hole on this entry at a cost of \$12,670. We abandoned that hole, partly because of the cost, but also because Canyon View came on the horizon.

We are now considering deepening that hole in search of water. There are some wells in the area with depths of 1,000' to 1,500' which are pumping from the 400' to 500' depth and are good producers.

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
