On August 4, 1975, Mr. F. P. Lynch of Declo, Idaho filed with the Department of Water Resources an application for permit to appropriate 1.07 cubic feet per second of water from a groundwater source in Lot 4, Sec. 1, Twp. 11S, Rge. 24E., B.M. Cassia County for irrigation of 74.1 acres of land within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Lot 4 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Sec. 1, Twp. 11S, Rge. 24E., B.M.

The Department caused notice of the application to be published in the South Idaho Press, Burley, Idaho on August 12 and August 19, 1975. On August 21, 1975 the Department received a protest against the granting of said permit from Mr. William Darrington.

A conference in the matter was held in Twin Falls, Idaho on January 15, 1976. The issue of possible interference between the proposed well and the protestant's existing well was discussed. Both parties agreed to allow the Department to reach a decision in the matter based upon the information presented at the conference and all pertinent information in the files of the Department.

After reviewing the evidence and information presented at the conference, the Director of the Department of Water Resources makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

(1) The protestant has a water right for domestic purposes from a well located near the southeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 2, Twp. 11S, Rge. 24E., B.M., Cassia County.

(2) The nearest well to location of applicant's point of diversion is in excess of $\frac{1}{4}$ mile.

(3) In 1974 some of the water levels in the wells in the vicinity of the proposed well lowered which required them to be redrilled.

(4) The water level in the nearest observation well, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 32, Twp. 11S, Rge. 25E, has declined from 15.90 feet below the land surface in September 1966 to 30.45 feet in September 1974.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

(1) The evidence presented was not conclusive that direct interference caused some wells to go dry but to the contrary there appears to be a general lowering of the water table in the area.

(2) The Director of the Department of Water Resources is charged with the protection of reasonable groundwater pumping levels according to the doctrine of "first in time is first in right." However, this doctrine must not be used to hinder a full economic development of the underground resources.

(3) The present water level is above the reasonable economic pumping level for this area.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED and Application for Permit No. 45-7245 is APPROVED subject to the following conditions:

- (1) That the permit be and is subject to all prior existing water rights.
- (2) That a measuring device of a type approved by the Director of the Department of Water Resources be permanently installed and maintained as part of the diverting works.
- (3) That proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use be submitted to the Department of Water Resources before February 1, 1981.

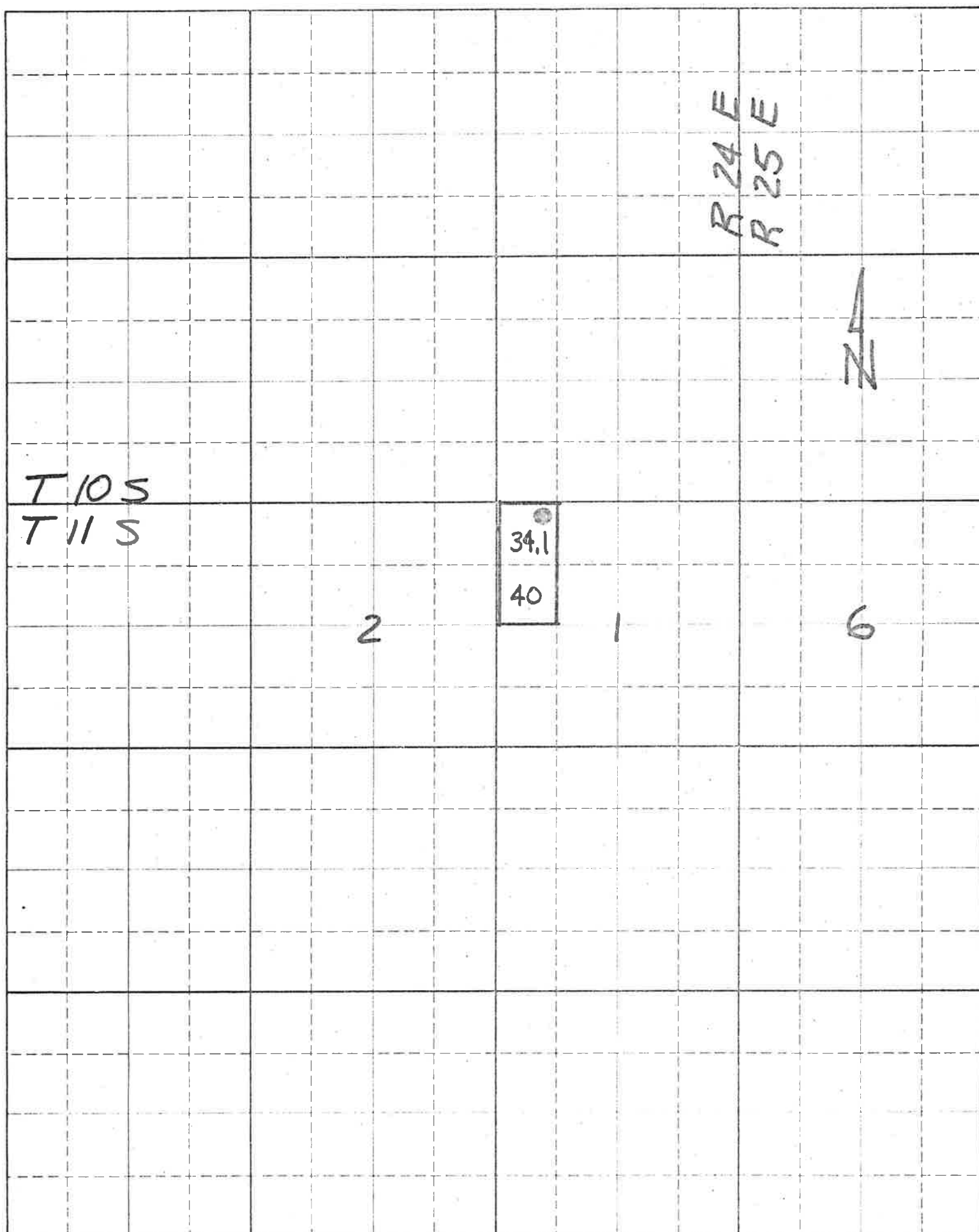
