The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows:

change point of diversion, add point of diversion, and change place of use. The proposed points of diversion are in SWSE Sec 30 T9S R41E and Lot 1 (NENE) Sec 1 T10S R40E for 1.02 cfs. The sources of water will remain as they currently exist, Soda Creek and Waste Water, but water will instead be diverted from Bear River. The proposed place of use is 51 acres within the service area of Last Chance Canal Co.




