We propose to construct a domestic well with sufficient capacity to provide water to a residence and approximately 2 acres of pasture. The subdivision was previously serviced through a gravity irrigation system from Farmers" Co-Operaive Ditch Company. The co-op removed the subdivisions head gate effectively stopping all gravity flow. There is no reasonable way to convey irrigation water to the site from the tale water source.
