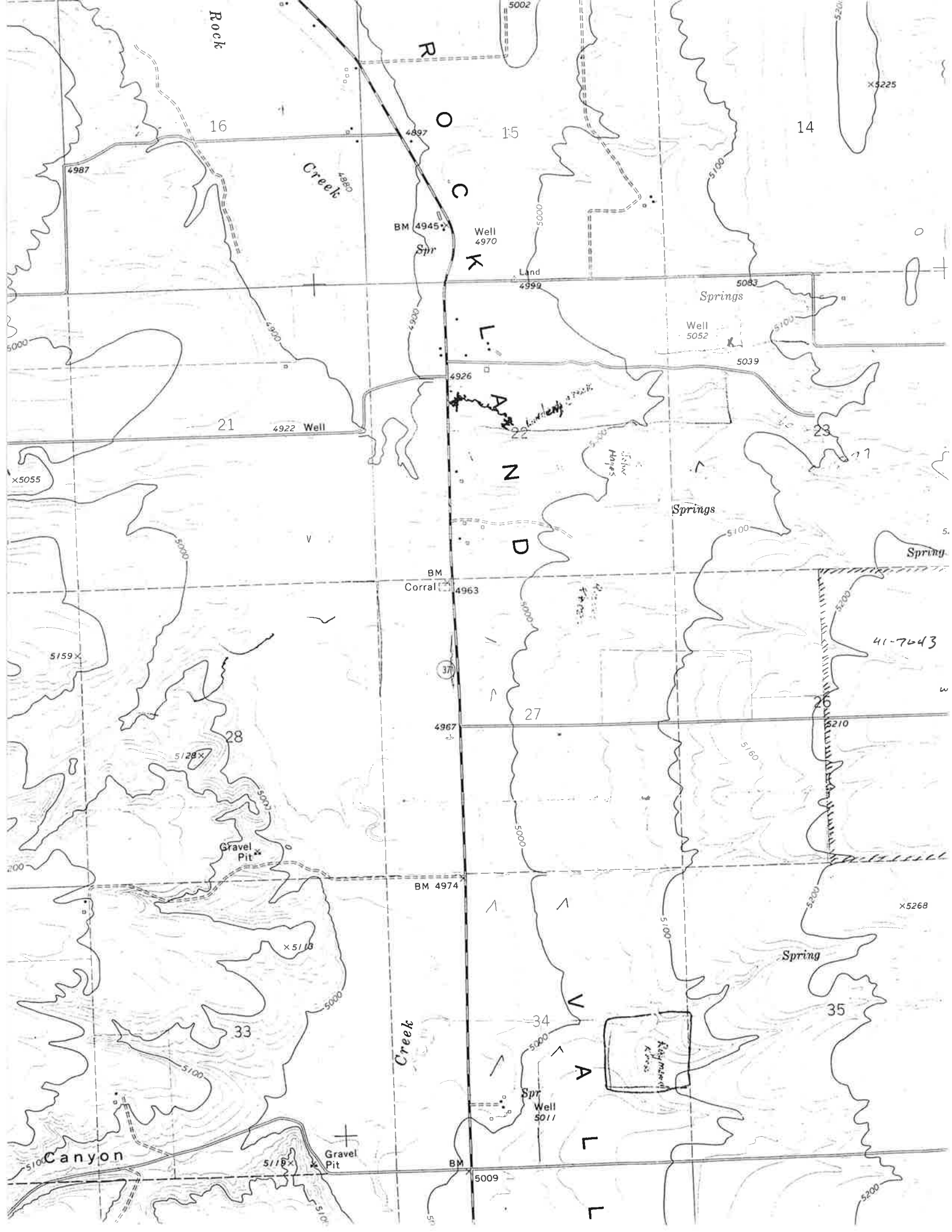

SUBJECT Permit 41-7015, Grant Udy & Sons

George was in today to amend this permit. When this permit was granted, the nearest 3-phase power was about two miles from the P/U. Idaho Power had told the applicant that power would be extended up the valley to near the P/U. Cutbacks by Idaho Power have prevented this, so no 3-phase power is available to operate irrigation pumps on the land. Diesel fuel is now too expensive to be economically feasible. So a well has been drilled but no irrigation has been developed on the land described in the permit. The applicants own a parcel of land west of Rockland. There is a groundwater license on this land, but it is only for 1/4" per acre. A second well has been drilled on the land but is not being used. The applicants also want to drill a third well. This water permit is being amended to move the water (for a total of 1" per acre) to the land west of Rockland. If we approve the amendment, they will immediately apply for a drilling permit for the third well. Since proof ~~1d/d~~ is due on 9-1-87, time is critical if everything is to be completed on time (within the 60 days allowable after the proof due date).

Dear Mr. Udy;

Based on our previous discussions on the above-referenced permit, it appears that water has never been actually put to beneficial use on the permitted lands. Just drilling the well is not sufficient to meet the development requirements of the permit.

There appears to be two options in this situation. If our licensing examination finds no beneficial use of water under the permit, we will have to cancel the permit. Since we would have made a field inspection, your examination fee of \$125. would not be returned.

The second option is for you to voluntarily relinquish the permit. If this is done, we can refund the examination fee. A relinquishment form has been prepared for your use. If you choose this second option, the later filing you made to irrigate Sections 1 and 12 will remain in effect pending Swan Falls processing.

Please let us know your decision in this matter at your earliest convenience. If you have further questions, please feel free to contact this office.

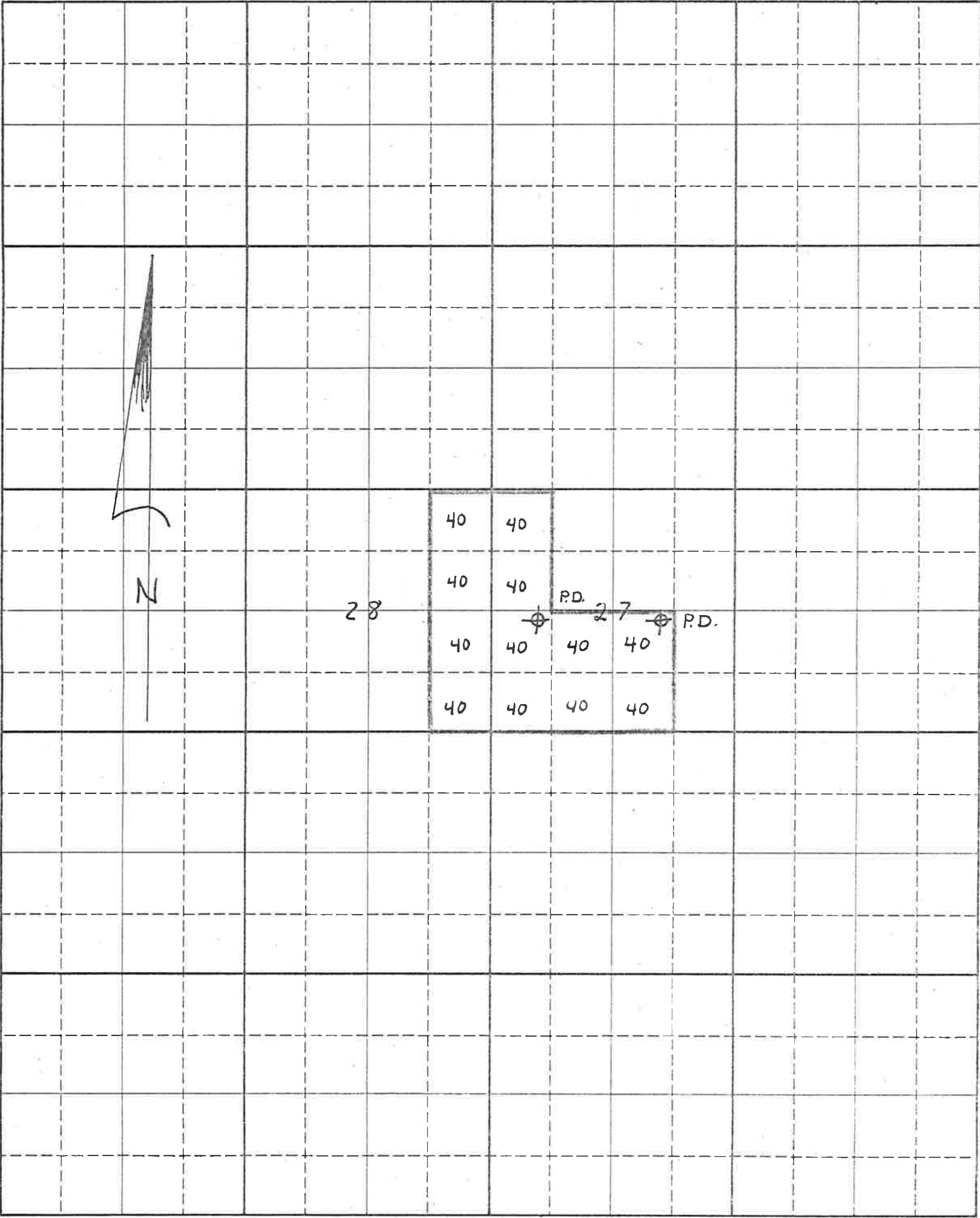
