

  4. The volume of the storage ponds shall not exceed 135 acre-feet. Diversions to and from storage in the ponds shall not exceed 500 acre-feet per year.
- Prior to diversion of water under this right, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works.
- In connection with the proof of beneficial use submitted for this permit, the permit holder shall also submit a report showing the total annual volume, the maximum daily volume, and the maximum instantaneous rate of flow diverted from the point of diversion authorized for this permit during the development period. The report shall also show the maximum instantaneous rate of diversion, either measured or reasonably estimated by a qualified professional engineer, geologist, or certified water rights examiner, for the entire municipal water system. The report shall also describe and explain how water diverted under this permit provides an additional increment of beneficial use of water for the municipal water system as opposed to an alternative point of diversion for prior water rights already held and used by the right holder for its municipal water system.
- 7. 26A Project construction shall commence within one year from the date of permit issuance and shall proceed diligently to completion unless it can be shown to the satisfaction of the Director of the Department of Water Resources that delays were due to circumstances over which the permit holder had no control.
- 8. 046 Right holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Idaho Code § 42-235 and applicable Well Construction Rules of the Department.
- 9. 004 This right does not grant any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
  10. 121 The Director retains jurisdiction to require the right holder to provide purchased or
- 10. 121 The Director retains jurisdiction to require the right holder to provide purchased or leased natural flow or stored water to offset depletion of Lower Snake River flows if needed for salmon migration purposes. The amount of water required to be released into the Snake River or a tributary, if needed for this purpose, will be determined by the Director based upon the reduction in flow caused by the use of water pursuant to this permit.
- 11. Prior to the diversion and use of water under this approval, the right holder shall comply with applicable water quality monitoring and/or permitting requirements administered by the Department of Environmental Quality or the Department of Agriculture.
- 12. 020 The diversion and use of water described in this right may be subject to additional conditions and limitations agreed to by the protestant and the right holder under a separate agreement to which the Department is not a party. Because the Department is not a party, the Department is not responsible for enforcement of any aspect of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions herein. Enforcement of those portions of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions shall be the responsibility of the protestant and the water right holder.

The protest settlement included assignment of part of this permit to IDL. The assignment form states the following:

"TMO assigns to IDL a co-ownership interest in Permit No. 65-23750 to the extent that it includes water that is beneficially used on, or that is diverted from wells located on, lands owned by the State of Idaho as set forth in Attachment A. This partial assignment is intended to result in TMO and IDL being named as co-owners of Permit No. 63-23750 in IDWR's records, and is not intended to cause a split of the Permit."

The reference to 63-23750 is a typographical error in the assignment document. "Attachment A" referenced in the statement above describes the "Golf Course parcel" and the "Ski Hill Parcel" and can be found in the backfile for this permit.
