RE: Recorded locations for water rights 37-8515, 37-8517, 37-8518

Dear Mr. & Mrs. D'Angelo:

In the process of reviewing your application to rent water from the Water Supply Bank, the Department found disagreements in the records for the water rights that are appurtenant to your property and the information provided in your application to rent. The legal descriptions of the points of diversion (PODs) and places of use (POUs) for water rights 37-8515, 37-8517, and 37-8518 are recorded in the SE ½ NW ½ of Section 14, Township 05 North, Range 17 East. The materials submitted with your lease and the Department's current GIS data place the PODs and POUs in the NE ½ NW ¼ of Section 14. After reviewing the scanned documents for these rights, it appears that the disagreements may be due to updates to the Public Lands Survey in your area since the time that these water rights were licensed.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of these disagreements. The Department does not require water users to file transfers in order to change the legal descriptions for POUs or PODs when there will be no physical change in the locations of the POUs or PODs. If you choose, you can file transfers to update the legal descriptions to the NE ¼ NW ¼ of Section 14. The applications for transfer would eliminate the disagreements noted above, and appear to qualify for the reduced application fee of \$50.00 per water right under Idaho Code § 42-221.O.8.
