The Department has prepared the attached draft permit approval that incorporates standard conditions required by the Department, including conditions reflecting the settlement reached between West Ada School District (Applicant) and Settlers Irrigation District (Protestant) in this contested matter. Note, the conditions of approval agreed to by the parties are similar in language and intent to standard Department conditions. The Department has included standard conditions in place of the stipulated conditions on the attached draft approval.

Conditions of Approval

- 1. Proof of application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before June 01, 2025.
- 2. Subject to all prior water rights.
- 3. This right is limited to the irrigation of 3.7 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
- 4. The diversion rate for this right shall not exceed 0.22 cfs. Provided further, this right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs, per acre when averaged over a twenty-four hour period based upon the amount of water applied over such twenty-four hour period. However, should the lands authorized to be irrigated under this right ever cease to be irrigated for public turf grass recognized by the Department as allowing more than one inch per acre, then this right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs, per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 5. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 4.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 6. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor exceed a combined annual maximum diversion volume of 16.7 af at the field headgate for the place of use
- 7. The right holder shall make full beneficial use of all surface water available to the right holder for irrigation of lands within the authorized place of use for this right. The right holder may divert ground water under this right to irrigate land with appurtenant surface water rights when the surface water supply is not reasonably sufficient to irrigate the place of use for this water right or is not available due

to drought, curtailment by priority, or the seasonal startup and shutoff or maintenance schedule for canal company deliveries. The right holder shall not divert ground water for irrigation purposes under this right if use of the surface water supply is intentionally discontinued or reduced (for example abandoned, forfeited, sold, disallowed by court decree, or leased to the Water Supply Bank), or is not deliverable due to non-payment of annual assessments, without an approved transfer pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-222 or other Department approval.

- 8. To prevent injury to prior water rights appropriating water from the underlying shallow aquifer, the well used as a point of diversion for this water right shall be constructed and maintained with unperforated casing and sealed into the first significant confining layer located 200 feet or more below ground surface.
- 9. Water bearing zone to be appropriated is 200 to 300 feet.

This permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-204.

- 10. The diversion and use of water described in this right may be subject to additional conditions and limitations agreed to by the protestant and the right holder under a separate agreement to which the Department is not a party. Because the Department is not a party, the Department is not responsible for enforcement of any aspect of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions herein. Enforcement of those portions of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions shall be the responsibility of the protestant and the water right holder.
- 11. Right holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Idaho Code § 42-235 and applicable Well Construction Rules of the Department.
- 12. The Director retains jurisdiction to require the right holder to provide purchased or leased natural flow or stored water to offset depletion of Lower Snake River flows if needed for salmon migration purposes. The amount of water required to be released into the Snake River or a tributary, if needed for this purpose, will be determined by the Director based upon the reduction in flow caused by the use of water pursuant to this permit.


