We propose to utilize an earthen embankment on Deep Creek to create a pond with 4.54 AF of stockwater storage. Up to 100 head of range cattle will drink directly from the pond. No diversion from the pond will occur. Evaporation loss has been calculated at a yearly average of 300 gallons/day. Total estimated daily water use for cattle and evaporation loss is 1500 gallons/day. Annual evaporation from pond is .32 AF.

Annual cattle consumption is 1.34 AF.

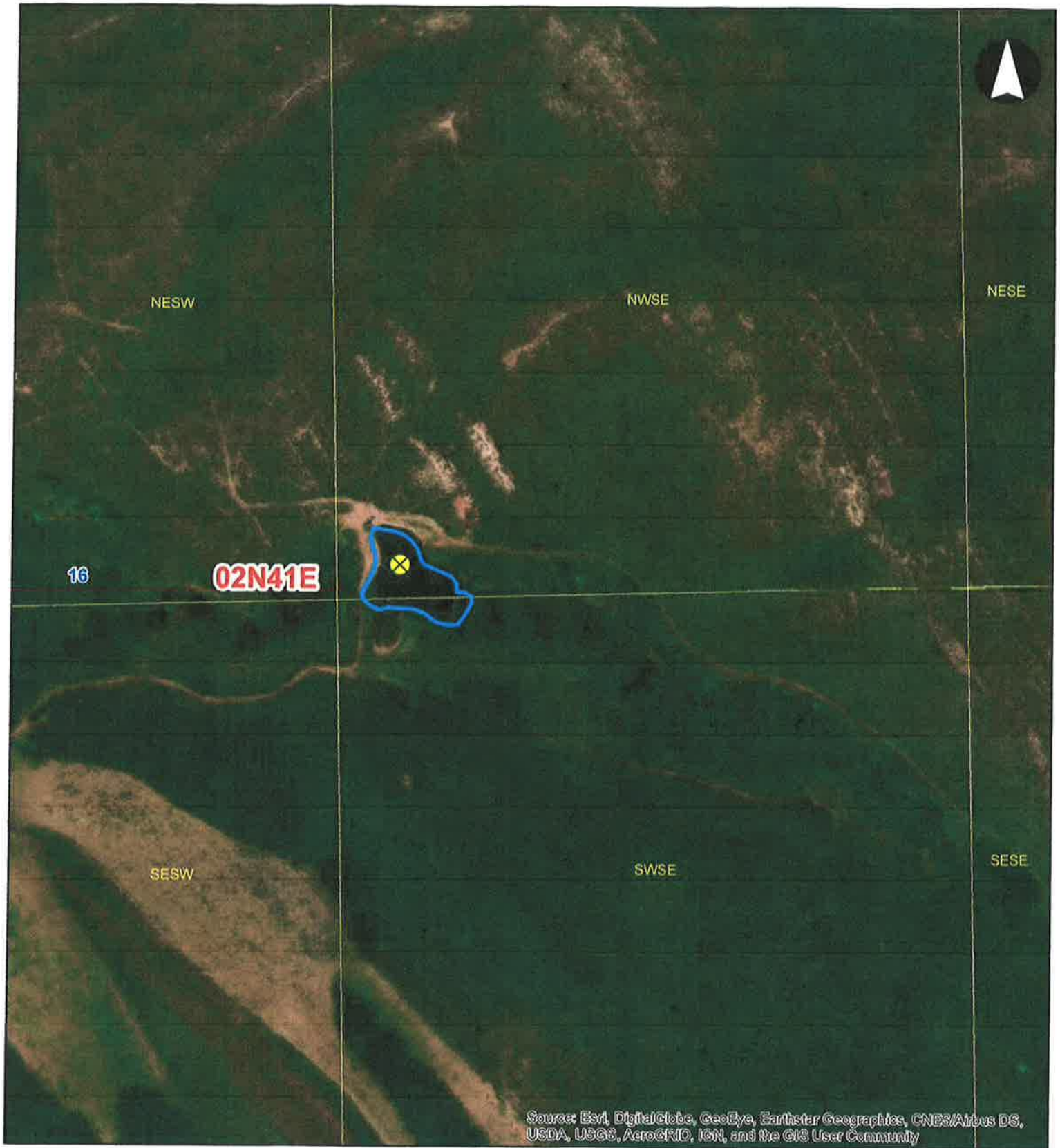
