MEMORANDUM

RE: Evaluation of the sufficiency of submitted information
DATE: December 2, 2019

Transfer application 83727 was submitted October 30, 2019 and proposed to add a point of diversion for a split portion of water right 63-31495. The right was split prior to transfer processing. The applicants' split portion is now numbered 63-34823. The proposed changes will be applied to the new split portion. The applicant was not required to amend the application.

The application indicates that the purpose of the transfer is to add a point of diversion. However, the information in the table in item B.3 describes only the new point of diversion, which appears to be an existing well on the property. I have taken this to mean that the applicants intend to change the point of diversion rather than add a second point. The wording and information on this application appears to have been copied from transfer application 83205. We interpreted 83205 as change the point of diversion. 83205 was approved on June 12, 2019; no petitions to clarify the intent were received.

Summary of Submitted Information

Authority to File:

The applicants are listed as John and Debra Meyer. The ownership change processed prior to transfer processing determined that the owners of the land are the same. Both owners signed the application. The applicants have the authority to file.

Water Right Validity:

The parent right, 63-31495, was decreed in 2009. The split portion of the right authorizes 3.5 acres of irrigation. It is unclear from the available aerial imagery when exactly the property was irrigated last, though it has certainly not been irrigated during the previous consecutive five-year period. I wrote a letter to the applicants on November 19, 2019 requesting information regarding the potential forfeiture of the water right. The applicants responded with a letter which was received on November 27, 2019. In the letter, the applicants explain they wish to resume use of the water right by planting grapes, fruit trees, and a garden. They have so far been unable to resume use because they do not own or have access to the original point of diversion which is located on Lot 5, Block 1 of the Applecreek Subdivision. The applicants could only resume use of the right following approval of the transfer and subsequent drilling of the requested well. The non-use of the right appears to have resulted from circumstances over which the water right owner has no control, which is one of the exceptions to forfeiture outlined in 42-223 *Idaho Code*. Therefore, though the right has not been used during the previous consecutive five-year period the applicant has provided evidence of an exception to forfeiture which is outlined in the Statute, thus the right is presumed valid.

Injury to Other Water Rights:

The well driller's report for the decreed point of diversion shows a water bearing zone of 332 to 342 ft below ground surface. However, the hole is only sealed the first 20 ft below the surface. Though there is

an eight-inch casing in an eight-inch hole from 20 ft to 332 ft below ground surface, there is the possibility that the minimal space around the casing allows water from above to infiltrate into the well below.

The priority date for the right pre-dates concerns regarding the appropriation of shallow groundwater tributary to the Boise River. The decreed point of diversion construction shows that the right may have historically used water tributary to the Boise River. Therefore the new well may be constructed to any depth including those <200 ft below ground surface without concern of injury to the fully appropriated reach of the Boise River.

Diversions from the new well will be accompanied by reduction in authorized diversion from the original point of diversion. There are several other wells in the same quarter-quarter. However, diversion from the new well for irrigation purposes under the transferred right will be limited to 0.06 cfs. No injury is anticipated to surrounding wells.

Enlargement of Use:

The transfer does not propose any change to the diversion rate or volume, the number of irrigated acres, nor any unsubordinated change to the season of use. No enlargement is anticipated.

Local Public Interest:

None of the available information suggests conflict with the local public interest.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources:

The application proposed beneficial use consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

The Idaho Dept. of Water Resources (IDWR) received your application proposing to add a point of diversion to your water right on October 30, 2019. IDWR is currently reviewing your application.


As part of its review, IDWR must evaluate if the right to be changed is valid (i.e. if the full right has been used during the previous consecutive five-year period). The right you propose to change (now numbered 63-34823) authorizes 3.5 acres of irrigation. However, aerial imagery dating back to 2014 seems to show that none of the land authorized by the right has been irrigated.

Your options for your application are as follows:

- 1) Describe in writing any attempts you have made to resume irrigation of the property during the previous consecutive five-year period.
- 2) Provide an argument for an exception to forfeiture as outlined in 42-223 *Idaho Code* (enclosed)
- 3) Withdraw your application and request a refund.
