

If the transfer proposes to relocate the place of use of an irrigation water right, and the relocated acres include land currently idled due to a Bank lease contract, the applicant is required to identify the areas that will be idled at the new place of use for the duration of the lease contract. The acres to be idled should be clearly identified on the map created for Attachment 7B of the transfer application. The applicant should confirm the map is attached when completing the table below. If the leased portion of the place of use is not proposed to be relocated, a map is not required.

A Bank lease contract shall remain in effect until it expires, a new lease proposal is processed to replace it, or the water right is released from the Bank through written confirmation issued by the Water Resource Board. If the proposed transfer is approved, the water right owner will be provided sufficient time to allow the lease contract to expire before beneficial use of water at the new place of use will be expected. 

EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. <u>It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:</u>

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. **Note:** the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the Department or the Water Resource Board is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the Department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

- (a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.
 - APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Evaluation of Sufficiency of Information Submitted

Application for transfer proposes to modify the place of use (POU) for a 12.0 acre portion of six ground water irrigation rights which irrigate 967.1 acres with a combined flow rate of 17.43 cfs. The current POU is located approximately 6.3 to 8.5 miles north and 0.7 mile west to 0.8 mile east of Malta, and the change will be made to land contiguous to the current POU.

A portion of the POU covers ground owned by a neighbor and a water sharing agreement has been included with the application to explain the water right ownership arrangement on that property.

The proposed transfer involves changing the POU of lands within Water District 143, so Watermaster comments were solicited. The Watermaster did not oppose the transfer. The proposed transfer involves modification of lands contiguous to the existing POU, so advertising is not necessary.

Authority to File:

The Department's database indicates that the water rights involved are owned by the applicant, East Valley Cattle, LLC. The application was signed by Bill Millenkamp, the manager of East Valley Cattle, LLC. See attachment from the Idaho Secretary of State office, 'Annual Report Form', for East Valley Cattle, LLC.
