

- 14. Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 161.



- 12. The un-leased portion of water diverted under this right shall not exceed the maximum volume of 189.0 af per year of which no more than 105.8 af per year can be consumptively used.
- 13. The maximum volume of water leased under this right shall not exceed 104 af per year of which no more that 58.2 af per year can be consumptively used.

Re: Review & Analysis of Application to Lease Water to the State Water Supply Bank

PURPOSE/NARRATIVE: Idaho Power submitted an application to lease on January 3, 2020. The proposed lease is 0.27 cfs and 104 AF from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2024. This application proposes a lease of the same quantity of water as the two previous lease contracts (2011 & 2015).

The review memo from March 11, 2011 notes that the lease appears to be intended to protect a portion of the water right designated for industrial and commercial use that the owner is currently unable to use in order to allow for potential expansion of the commercial and industrial processes in the future.

The water right includes irrigation, commercial and industrial uses. The portion of the water right proposed for lease only includes the commercial and industrial uses.

AUTHORITY TO FILE: The application was signed by Kresta Davis-Butts, who is listed in the contact information for the ownership records of this right. In a letter submitted with the application, Tess Park, Vice President of Power Supply, authorized Ms. Davis-Butts to act on behalf of Idaho Power in these matters. There are no concerns with the authority to file.

WATER RIGHT VALIDITY: This water right was created by a split from water right 61-2168 through a transfer in 2002. Idaho Power had purchased a portion of the original right for use at the power plant. The transfer was authorized on December 30, 2002, and Idaho Power was given 5 years to develop the use and complete the transfer.

104 AF of water from this right has been continuously leased to the Water Supply Bank since 2009, which is the first year after the development period of the right. 2009 is potentially the sixth year of non-use of the water dedicated to this right during the transfer. According to the guidance in Administrative Memorandum - Multiple Programs #2, any portion of a right that is protected before the end of the sixth year of non-use is considered protected. The 104 AF portion of this right that is proposed for lease is considered valid.

Based on the maximum diversion volumes as reported for WMIS site no. 101800, plus the volume of the leased portion of this right, there may be 77.2 AF or more of this right that are at risk of forfeiture due to non-use.

INJURY TO OTHER WATER RIGHTS: There is no apparent risk of injury to other water rights. The transfer creating this water right was protested, and the conditions for approval of the transfer should remain on this portion of the water right for lease and rental. Comments were requested from Western Region and WD 161 on January 28, 2020.

ENLARGEMENT OF USE: If the water from this proposed lease is rented, the required monitoring of the well used as the point of diversion for the water right should help ensure that the use has been idled. The point of diversion is shared with water right 61-11968 at WMIS site no. 101800.

To prevent enlargement through the rental, conditions for approval of this right (61-11939) should be considered. The total diversion volume of the water right is 293.4 AFA, with a maximum consumptive use volume defined in the conditions for approval as 164 AFA. Previous lease contracts have allocated the consumptive use available for rent proportionally. The same calculation will be used for this contract.

$$\frac{\textit{Leased diversion volume}}{\textit{Total diversion volume}}* \textit{Total consumptive use} = \textit{Rentable consumptive use} \\ \frac{104 \, \textit{AFA}}{293.4 \, \textit{AFA}} * 164 \, \textit{AFA} = 58.1 \, \textit{AFA}$$

LOCAL PUBLIC INTEREST: Review staff has no information to suggest this application is inconsistent with the local public interest.

BENEFICIAL USE/CONSERVATION OF WATER RESOURCES: The lease appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

DEPARTMENT STAFF OR WATERMASTER COMMENTS: The water right's point of diversion is located in Water District 161. The watermaster for WD 161 and regional staff did not respond to the request for comments, so it is assumed there are no concerns.
