ORDER AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CHANGE

TC-34-164

WHEREAS, a drought emergency has been declared for Butte County to allow administrative actions to lessen the severe impacts of the drought conditions in the county; and

WHEREAS, section 42-222A, Idaho Code, provides that upon declaration of a drought emergency, the director of the Department of Water Resources ("Department") is authorized to allow temporary changes in the point of diversion, the place of use, and the purposes of use for valid existing water rights or temporary exchanges of water authorized under water rights when the director determines that such changes can be accomplished in accordance with the provisions of section 42-222A, Idaho Code; and

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2020, Joel Andersen submitted the attached temporary change application TC-34-164 to the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Department has reviewed the application and has determined the application can be approved with certain conditions;

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application is APPROVED subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Diversion and use of the changed portions of rights 34-2397A, 34-2412C, 34-2409A, and 34-7210A is authorized only at the point of diversion and place of use described on the application.
- 2. This temporary change approval does not authorize construction of a new well as a point of diversion.
- 3. The applicant assumes all risk of curtailment or mitigation should the diversion and use of water under the temporary change approval cause injury to other water rights, constitute an enlargement in use of the original right, be inconsistent with the conservation of water resources within the state of Idaho, or not be in the local public interest.
- 4. This temporary change approval may only be used to provide a replacement water supply to lands or other uses that normally have a full water supply, except for the drought conditions. This temporary change approval may not be used to provide water for new development or to allow expansion of the use of water under existing water rights.

- 5. Rights 34-299 and 34-2397A when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 3.12 cfs and the irrigation of 120 acres.
- 6. Right 34-2409A is limited to the irrigation of 110 acres within the authorized places of use in a single irrigation season. Rights 34-2409A and 34-12034A when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 2.20 cfs and a total annual maximum diversion volume of 462 af.
- 7. Rights 34-2409A, 34-28D, 34-61C, 34-373C, 34-891A, 34-892C, 34-897, 34-898, and 34-12034A when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 3.77 cfs and the irrigation of 132 acres.
- 8. Applicant shall make full beneficial use of all surface water rights available for irrigation of the lands authorized to be irrigated under right 34-2412C. Applicant shall limit the diversion of ground water under right 34-2412C to those times when the surface water supply is not available or the surface water supply is not reasonably sufficient to irrigate the place of use authorized under the right.
- 9. Rights 34-2412C, 34-259F, 34-738E, 34-60, and 34-13562 when combined shall not exceed the irrigation of 142.1 acres in a single irrigation season.
- 10. This temporary approval does not authorize the use of diversion works or a delivery system owned by or managed by a corporation or an irrigation district without the written consent of such corporation or irrigation district.
- 11. The applicant agrees to hold the director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of the diversion and use of water under this temporary change approval.
- 12. This temporary change does not grant any right-of-way or easement to use the diversion works or conveyance works of another person or entity.
- 13. The Watermaster of Water District No. 34 is authorized to administer the temporary change approval.
- 14. This temporary change approval expires on November 1, 2020 unless rescinded or extended by the director. Thereafter, the water right shall revert to the point of diversion, place of use, and nature of use existing prior to the temporary change approval.













2020 Temporary Change - Water Rights 34-2412C











2020 Temporary Change - Water Right 34-7210A
