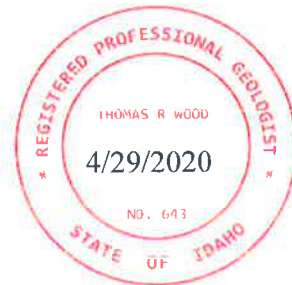
This application does not propose any irrigation. The property currently has a surface water right for irrigation (Water Right No. 29-11059).

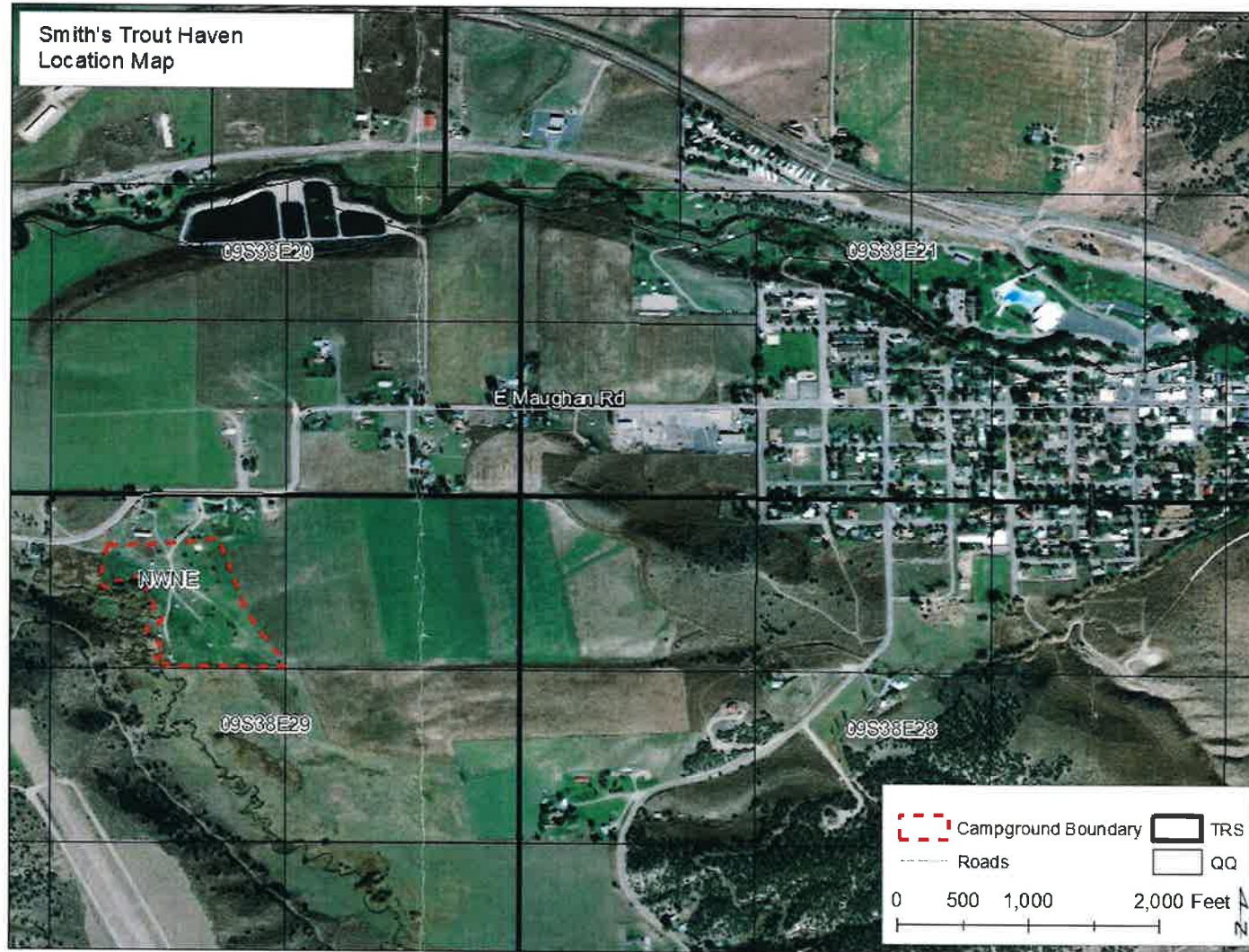


Figure 1: Site Location Map

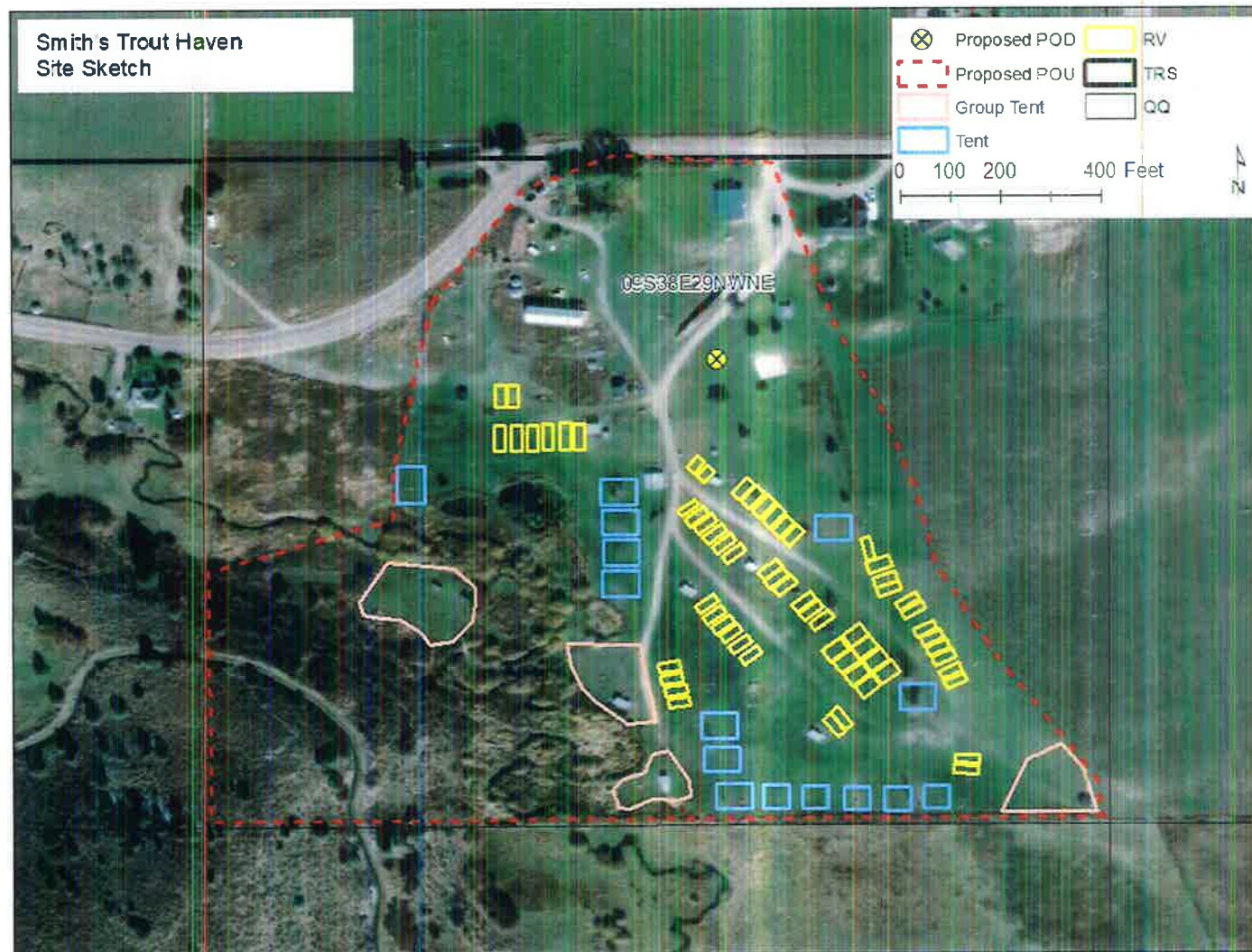


Figure 2: Site Layout and Proposed Well Location
