RBA LLC, PO BOX 370, KIMBERLY, ID 83341-0370 has filed Application No. 83959 for changes to the following water rights within MINIDOKA County(s): Right No(s). 36-17143, 36-17144, 36-17145, 36-17146. The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows:

Application for transfer proposes to change the point of diversion (POD) for four ground water irrigation rights with a combined flow rate of 0.03 cfs. The rights are currently authorized to divert from three wells located approximately 9.0 miles north and 2.0 miles west of Paul. After the transfer, the authorized POD will be a single existing well located approximately 1.0 mile west of the current PODs.

Permits will be subject to all prior water rights. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-222 and 42-203A, Idaho Code.
