





Mr. Darrington:

This letter is in response to your phone call today where you requested that I write a memo regarding the transfer application you submitted to the Department on 2/4/2020. As you recall the application proposed a place of use change for water rights 45-7501, 45-7249 and 45-7551. After receiving the application and conducting a preliminary review of the application, I returned it to you along with a deficiency letter on 2/12/2020 (copy of letter enclosed) indicating multiple reasons why the application could not be processed as submitted.

On 3/12/2020 you came into the office with additional paperwork to address some of the issues the letter had requested. When I asked you how you could actually accomplish what you were proposing in the transfer, i.e. drying up ground actually irrigated under the ground water right in order to move those acres to new ground, you indicated you couldn't dry up ground under the pivot by installing pivot stops in that location because the water was co-mingled with Burley Irrigation District (BID) canal shares. I responded that without drying up ground as indicated in the 2/12/2020 deficiency letter that you could continue with the transfer, but there was a strong possibility the application could be rejected as proposed. You then requested a refund, and I put in the request for a refund that same day (refunded 3/16/2020, see attached receipt).

Dear Mr. Darrington:

This letter is in reference to an application for transfer that you submitted to the Department on 2/4/2020. Further review of the application indicates it is incomplete and cannot be accepted for processing as submitted. We are returning the application to allow you or a representative to complete the necessary items. The required information is described below.

Both Mark L and Verla Darrington are listed as current owners on the water rights. Therefore, signatures from both owners are required on the transfer application.

The Fee was not provided correctly. The provided fee was based on 1.65 cfs. After reviewing the intent of the application to move 110.2 acres to new ground and create a 417.6 acre permissible place of use, it is clear that the provided fee of \$580.00 is insufficient. Since the application is seeking to create a permissible place of use that is approximately twice the size of the authorized acres for irrigation under the largest water right, the fee is based on the total allowed flow rate of the water rights. All three water rights when combined are limited to a combined flow rate of 5.47 cfs, which sets the total fee for this application at \$900.00. An additional fee of \$320.00 will be required before this application can be processed.

No proof of ownership, such as a copy of a warranty deed, for the new ground where portions of the water rights are proposed to be moved to was provided. Additionally, you indicated the new ground the transfer proposes to move 110.2 acres to is leased, the Department will also require that some form of agreement must be provided that indicates the property owner is willing to let you irrigate his ground and allow you to retain ownership of the water rights, or otherwise address the ownership of the rights if the transfer is approved as proposed.

Water Rights 45-7249 and 45-7551 list Rabo Agrifinance as a Security Interest on the water rights. As such, the Department will require a letter from them indicating they have no objection to what the transfer is proposing and/or to remove them as Security Interests on the water rights if the mortgage has been satisfied.

An additional issue that needs to be considered is how you are going to actually accomplish what the transfer proposes. Since you indicated that all the ground water is co-mingled with BID shares and the transfer application is proposing to dry up ground water in the NENW (Government Lot 3) and the SENW of Sec. 1, Twp 11S, Rge 24E, and the pivot center extends into the SENW, drying up the acres as proposed will not accommodate pivot stops and actual irrigation under the pivot. It appears that drying up acres in the NWNE (Government Lot 2) and SENE to create an area that could actually be dried up under the

pivot and reflect the actual irrigation that will result from the installation of pivot stops.

I am returning the application for transfer to you. If the application is not resubmitted within 30 days of the date on this letter with the appropriate corrections, the currently submitted application filing fee (\$580.00, receipt #S037746) will be refunded to you.
