- 1. The Board is authorized under chapter 17, title 42, Idaho Code to operate a water supply bank and to contract with lessors to act as an intermediary in facilitating the rental of water.
- 2. The Lessor has filed a completed application to lease water rights described below into the Water Supply Bank on forms supplied by the Idaho Department of Water Resources and received by the Department on November 01, 2019.
- The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources has reviewed the application for compliance with the Water Supply Bank rules and has approved the Lease subject to conditions listed below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and contracts herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. **WATER RIGHTS**: The Lessor shall lease and the Board shall accept into the Bank the Applicant's water rights described as follows:

2. **COMPENSATION**: The Lessor shall accept and the Board shall pay compensation determined by the amount of water rented under the following rental rate during such times as the water is rented from the Bank over the term of this Lease.

Minimum Payment Acceptable: Current Rental Rate

- 3. **TERM OF LEASE**: The term of this lease shall be January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. This Lease shall bind the parties and take effect when both parties have signed it.
- 4. WATER SUPPLY BANK CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE: The Lessor shall abide by all terms and conditions contained in the Water Supply Bank Conditions of Acceptance, attached hereto as "Attachment A" and incorporated herein by this reference.

- 5. CHANGE OF WATER RIGHT: This lease specifies water right elements including but not limited to: diversion rates; diversion volumes; number of acres authorized to be irrigated; places of use; points of diversion; beneficial uses; and seasons of use. During the term of this lease, if a water right is administratively changed due to a water right split and renumbering, this lease may be reduced by an equal amount to reflect the water right elements as legally defined under the water right. If a lease contract cannot be reduced sufficient to reflect the legal definition of a water right as amended through a water right split and/or water right transfer, the Board may release the water right from the Water Supply Bank.
- 6. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT: This lease is between the Board and the Lessor, who is the recognized owner or designated representative of the recognized owners of water rights described herein. Should ownership of any part of a water right herein described change during the term of this lease, either through a water right split, a water right transfer, sale of property to which the water right is appurtenant, or through any other recognized water right reassignment, the lease benefits and obligations to the conditions of acceptance for any such water rights will be assigned to the new owners.
- 7. **DUPLICATE ORIGINAL**: This Lease is executed in duplicate. Each of the documents with an original signature of each party shall be an original.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate.
- 2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.
- 3. While a right is in the bank, the lessor may <u>not</u> use the right without approval of the Department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-351 for illegal diversion and use of water and may include civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701B.
- 4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, or the lease term expires. A right may be released from the bank upon request, provided the Board approves the release. Unless approved by the Department, leased rights may not be immediately available for release.
- 5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-223(5).
- 6. Rental of water under this right is subject to the limitations and conditions of approval of the water right.
- 7. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.
- 8. Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other Department application process.




- 9. In accordance with Idaho Code § 42-248 and § 42-1409(6), all owners of water rights are required to notify the Department of any changes in mailing address or change in ownership of all or part of a water right. Notice must be provided within 120 days of the change.
- 10. If a water right leased into the Water Supply Bank is sold or conveyed during the lease term, and if the leased right was rented, the rental proceeds will be disbursed in the following manner regardless of any arrangements between the buyer(s) and seller(s) to the contrary:
 - a. Rental payments will go to the lessor(s) of record at the beginning of the rental season, even if the Department processes a Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership during the rental season.
 - b. New lessor(s) of record will receive payment for any subsequent rental seasons.
- 11. The water right(s) is leased to the bank subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
- 12. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
- 13. The period of use for the irrigation described in this approval may be extended to a beginning date of 3/15 and an ending date of 11/15 provided that beneficial use of the water can be shown and other elements of the right are not exceeded. The use of water before 4/1 and after 10/31 is subordinate to all water rights having no subordinated early or late irrigation use and a priority date earlier than a date the partial decree is entered for this right.
- 14. Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 2.
- 15. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1412(6), this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.
- 16. The following rights are diverted through point of diversion described above: 02-7059, 02-7060B, 02-7061, 02-7062, 02-7064, 02-7168A, 02-7168B, 02-7168C, 02-7237A, 02-7275, 02-7279A, 02-10180, & 02-10181.

Re: Water Supply Bank Lease Application 1489, 1498, 1499, 1500

Purpose/Narrative: Four applications to lease 2-7064, 2-7237A, 2-10181, and 2-10189 were received by the Department on November 1, 2019. The applicant has requested to place the entirety of the rights into the Water Supply Bank through 2020, extending their current lease for another year. These applications are part of a lease/rental package similar to previous years with Owyhee Farming Co LLC requesting to rent the entirety of what can be made available.

Review of the previous lease found that it appeared there had been irrigation in 2011, 2013, & 2017 of the acreage covered by parts of these water rights. IDWR compliance was contacted and found that they had dry farmed the area and any water use would have been from rainfall.

There also appears to be a combined use limit attached to these rights however, it appears that this may be a historic data point that may need updated. Some of the rights within the limit have been split into child water rights and some of the child rights were disallowed. This lease will not recognize the data point and recommends it be updated to reflect actual limits, should any exist.

Authority to File: The applications were submitted by Crown Farm Outback, c/o Crown West Realty LLC, through their representative, Bryce Farris, and they were signed by Oliver Lawrence, who listed himself as an 'authorized representative' of Crown Farm Outback LLC. Mr. Lawrence has also previously represented himself as the asset manager for Crown Farm Outback, through his signing of prior Water Supply Bank lease contracts for the company. Crown Farm Outback directly acquired the water rights from the prior water right owners, who continue to own the land to which these water rights are appurtenances. No concerns about Mr. Lawrence, nor Crown Farm Outback's authority to file these lease applications.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: Water rights 2-7064 and 2-7237A were licensed in 1985, as was 2-7060 (which is the parent water right from which 2-10181 originates); the three rights were leased to the Bank from 1999 through 2017, during which time they were decreed by the SRBA Court (2009). Water right 2-10189 was leased to the Bank from 1991 through 2017, during which time it too was decreed by the SRBA Court (2011). The four water rights were fully leased to the Bank again in 2018 and 2019. No concerns about water right validity.

Injury Evaluation: No injury is apparent through lease alone, Water district 2 and the Bybee Canal association will be contacted for comments regarding conveyance losses to avoid possible injury.

Enlargement of Use: No enlargement is evident through the lease alone, proper rental review should protect against enlargement.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the lease.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The lease appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster, IDWR Southern Region, and The Bybee Canal association's comments have been requested December 26, 2019.

Good morning, I was given your email address as part of the Bybee Canal Association. Attached are four maps depicting the place of use where irrigation is authorized under water rights 2-7064, 2-7237A, 2-10181, and 2-10189. These four rights, held by Crown Farm Outback LLC, have been in the Water Supply Bank from 1999 through December 31, 2019 and applications to lease them back to the Bank through 2020 were recently received by IDWR.

Our WSB rules (IDAPA 37.02.03.25.02e – WSB Rule 25.02.e) require that where the right to water includes diversion via a join diversion works owned or operated by a company, corporation (or in the case of the Bybee Canal, an association/organization), that written consent from the owner/operator of the diversion works should be included with the lease application.

Because the four above-listed water rights authorize diversion of Snake River water via the Bybee Canal, I am reaching out to you, to obtain written comments from a representative of the Bybee Canal, regarding this lease proposal. Previously it was mentioned that Jack Post and/or Darren Agenbroad may be the presently authorized representative of the Bybee Canal. If that is correct, could you please forward this email to Mr. Post or Mr. Agenbroad, so that we might obtain from them written confirmation that the Bybee Canal does not object and does consent to the lease of these four water rights into the Bank for 2020.
