Use of rental water shall be authorized as of either the date this rental agreement takes effect or the first day of the rental season of use, in 2020, whichever occurs last.

Annual Rental Fee:

2020 - 2022: \$1,086.00 annually 2023 - 2024: \$1,248.90 annually

The full fee for the rental of the above-described right(s) is \$1,086.00 per year for years 2020 - 2022 and \$1,248.90 per year for years 2023 - 2024. The rental fee includes an administrative fee of \$108.60 per year for years 2020 - 2022 and \$124.89 per year for years 2023 - 2024.

An annual payment shall be received by the Department on or before December 31 each year preceding the use of the rented water rights. The agreement will be void if payment is not received by the due date in a given year. Rental fees are non-refundable. To voluntarily terminate the agreement early, notify the Department in writing prior to the rental fee due date.

RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- 2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. Prior to December 31 of each year, the Board may review this rental agreement to determine whether it is consistent with the management plan that may be approved for the Eastern Snake Plain Aguifer Ground Water Management Area ("ESPA GWMA Plan") pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-233b. The Board may cancel this rental agreement if the Board determines it is not consistent with the ESPA GWMA plan. If this rental agreement is canceled, the cancellation shall not take effect until December 31 of the year in which the rental agreement is canceled.


- 10. The period of use for the irrigation described under right 21-7089 in this approval may be extended to a beginning date of 4/1 provided that beneficial use of the water can be shown and other elements of the right are not exceeded. The use of water under right 21-7089 before 5/15 is subordinate to all water rights having no subordinated early irrigation use and a priority date earlier than 11/2/2011.
- 11. Right 21-12952 is subordinate to all water rights with a priority date earlier than April 12, 1994, that are not decreed as enlargements pursuant to Section 42-1426, Idaho Code. As between water rights decreed as enlargements pursuant to Section 42-1426, Idaho Code, the earlier priority right is the superior right.
- 12. Pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1412(6), this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court in the final unified decree entered 08/26/2014.
- 13. Use of water under this right may be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 110.
- 14. Upon specific notification of the Department, the right holder shall install and maintain data loggers to record water usage information at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications.
- 15. Prior to the diversion and use of water under this rental agreement, the right holder shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device(s) at the authorized point(s) of diversion in accordance with Department specifications, or shall obtain an approved variance from the Department to determine the amount of water diverted from power records or to maintain an existing measuring device.
- 16. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.





Eastern Snake Plain Aquifer Modeling Analysis and Narrative

WSB Rental Application for WR#21-7089 and 21-12952

The Applicant requires an additional 15.5 acres at the proposed place of use to irrigate acres under the end gun of a pivot. This application proposes to rent water from water right nos. 21-7089 and 21-12952 for the 2020-2024 seasons that will cover the acres required. These rights are being offered to the Bank under a companion application.

Data Input Values

The TO Well location is an existing point of diversion for water rights 31-12283 and 31-12285. The model cell is identified as R42 C175.

The FROM Well location is the sole diversion for the proposed rented water rights. The model cell is identified as R50 C187. Figure 1 shows the locations of the points of diversion used in the modeling scenario.

The standard consumptive use volume of 2.5 afa/acre was used to calculate a volume for modeling. Both the TO and the FROM wells share the same standard diversion volume. For 15.5 acres of rental, a total annual consumptive volume of 38.75 af, or 12.9 af/trimester was used in the modeling simulation.







Figure 3. Net Transfer Graphs








Figure 4. Calculated Affects Beginning Prior to Proposed Rental Period

Purpose/Narrative: An application was received on behalf of Mr. Egbert on December 30, 2019 as part of a lease/rental package requesting a five year rental of water rights held by Charlotte Parker. This is a continuation of a single year rental for 2019 as a response to an NOV dated April 1, 2019 (E2019-1380). Prior to the 2019 rental Mr. Egbert had received an NOV in 2015 also for this place of use. Mr. Egbert has also attempted to transfer water rights to this place of use permanently however, it appears they have been protested. Review of the documentation provided indicates that the protest was filed regarding forfeiture of the water rights being transferred and is not related to injury at this time.

Authority to File: The application was submitted by Kristin Moore of Rocky Mountain Environmental on behalf of Mr. Egbert. Review of the parcel data indicates Mr. Egbert is the current land owner.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: Mr. Egbert has requested the rental of water rights held by Charlotte Parker. These rights are currently leased to the Bank and remain valid. No concerns at this time.

Injury Evaluation: ESPA modeling was provided in the application package and verified using the most current version of the ETRAN. No injury is apparent at this time.

Enlargement of Use: While there are water rights that will be used in conjunction with this rental, they are not authorized to cover the acreage being irrigated with the end guns of the pivot system. To further prevent enlargement the rental will be limited to the same rate per acre and volume per acre as the water rights being used at the rental location.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the rental.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster and IDWR Eastern Region comments were requested February 24, 2020

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Bank staff recommend the approval of this application
