Jim,

As part of the processing procedure for these transfer applications we must review and evaluate several elements of the water rights. One of the things we must evaluate is the water right validity, which includes whether or not the right is subject to forfeiture. After reviewing aerial imagery (2013, 2015, and 2017) of the place of use, it appears that the place of use has gone through a period of 5 or more years of non-use. Idaho Code 42-223 provides for exceptions, or defenses, to forfeiture. Can you provide an acceptable defense to forfeiture for the water rights?
