This application proposes the diversion and use of water from ground water tributary to the Salmon Wild & Scenic River. The decreed minimum stream flow rights for the federal Wild & Scenic Rivers are subordinate to certain categories of water use and to specific amounts of water use established after the minimum stream flow. The water use proposed in this application will benefit from the subordination provision because the diversion rate will be applied to the subordination amounts specified in the decree for

the Wild & Scenic River listed above.

Permits will be subject to all prior water rights.
