This rental agreement shall take effect when all parties have signed it and shall continue in effect until December 31, 2024. Use of rental water shall be authorized as of either the date this rental agreement takes effect or the first day of the rental season of use, in 2020, whichever occurs last.

Annual Rental Fee:

2020 - 2022: \$590.00 annually 2023 - 2024: \$678.50 annually

The full fee for the rental of the above-described right(s) is \$590.00 per year for years 2020 – 2022 and \$678.50 per year for years 2023 – 2024. The rental fee includes an administrative fee of \$59.00 per year for years 2020 – 2022 and \$67.85 per year for years 2023 - 2024.

An annual payment shall be received by the Department on or before December 31 each year preceding the use of the rented water rights. The agreement will be void if payment is not received by the due date in a given year. Rental fees are non-refundable. To voluntarily terminate the agreement early, notify the Department in writing prior to the rental fee due date.

RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- 2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. Use of water under this agreement will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 37B.
- 10. The period of use for the irrigation described in this approval may be extended to an ending date of 10/31 provided that beneficial use of the water can be shown and other elements of the agreement are not exceeded. The use of water and after 10/15 is subordinate to all water rights having no subordinated late irrigation use and a priority date earlier than 09/24/2010.



- 12. Prior to diversion of water under this agreement, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works.




Attachment to Water Supply Bank Rental Agreement No. 382



Re: Water Supply Bank Rental Application 1615

Purpose/Narrative: An application was received January 2, 2020 from the Barber Family Associates LP requesting a five year rental of water right 37-7697. This is a renewal of their previous rental from 2015 through the end of 2019. The applicant has requested to use the same water right as they had previously and would like to cover the same place of use. The rental is within the Big Wood River Ground Water Management Area as well as the Camas Creek water district.

Authority to File: The applications were signed and submitted by George Barber on behalf of the LP, review of the Washington Secretary of State data indicates that he is a governor for the partnership. The Camas County parcel data also shows that the place of use indicated is also owned by the partnership. No concerns at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: The water right being requested was initially decreed in 2010 and portion shave been offered to the Bank beginning in 2015. No concerns of validity at this time.

Injury Evaluation: No injury is apparent through the rental as the renter is located within the same basin as the right being leased. No concerns of injury at this time.

Enlargement of Use: No concerns of enlargement as there are no other irrigation water rights located within the place of use. The applicant has indicated that they are searching for a permanent right to transfer to this location for this use.

Local Public Interest: Review staff have no information to suggest this rental is inconsistent with the local public interest.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster and IDWR Southern Region comments will be requested.

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Pending comments from the IDWR regional office and watermaster, Bank staff recommend the approval of this rental.
