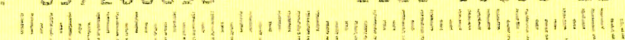

You are hereby notified that under the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-218A, the above referenced permit has lapsed and is of no further force nor effect. The department provided the proper forms to you in the proof due notice dated January 31, 2020. No further construction or additional development is authorized under this permit.

If water was put to beneficial use prior to the date proof of beneficial use was due, you may file the Statement of Completion (proof) now, or if you or a previous owner of this permit have not received a prior extension of time, you may file the Request for Extension of Time (extension request) if the delay is for reasonable cause as provided in Idaho Code § 42-204. You may also request an extension of time if you have been delayed by a government agency, or by litigation that brings title to the water in question.

Either an acceptable proof or an acceptable extension request must be received by this Department within sixty (60) days of the mailing of this lapse notice in order to reinstate this permit.
