Dear Waterusers:

As of April 19, 2010 your water right is out of priority. You must cease all diversions effective immediately.

You may purchase water thru the Boise River Rental Pool to allow you to continue to irrigate the area serviced by your water right. I have estimated that you will need approximately 150 acre feet of water based on the .44 cfs portion of your water right for irrigation thru October 15, 2010. This rental will be required each year to provide you with an uninterrupted supply.

As a condition of your water right you are required to install a lockable headgate and approved measuring device. This is a requirement for all diversions on the Boise River. These devices must be installed and operational by the beginning of the 2011 irrigation season or your water rights may be curtailed until such time as the installation is complete.

Riverside Village Homeowners Association will receive a tax notice from the Boise River Watermaster's office each year beginning in 2011. This bill is for measuring and accounting for your annual water usage. This bill will be in addition to the annual purchase required from the Boise River Rental Pool.
