As you are aware the conditions of your Permit to Appropriate Water, No. 63-32602 requires you to provide the Boise River Watermaster access to an acceptable measuring device for the purpose of measuring the flows in accordance with the Stewart Decree associated with your water right.

According to the permit. "Prior to diversion of water under this right, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Proof of application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before December 01, 2009.
2. Subject to all prior water rights.
3. This right is limited to the irrigation of 24 acres within the place of use described above in a single irrigation season.
4. Prior to diversion of water under this right, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works.
5. Use of water under this right will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 63 & Boise River District.
6. Water stored under this right is subject to fluctuations of the water table caused by changes in the flow of local streams and by diversions under prior ground water rights. This right does not guarantee the maintenance of any particular ground water level.
7. This right does not authorize construction of a well.
8. To mitigate for the depletion of water and injury to senior right holders resulting from the use of this right, the right holder shall retain 31 shares representing 0.62 cfs under Pioneer Ditch Company Water Right 63-183. Moreover, the official record for Water Right 63-183 will reflect a 0.62 cfs portion to remain in the Boise River for mitigation of this right.
9. Storage is for one excavated pond not to exceed a total capacity of 215 acre feet and a total surface area of 7 acres.

This permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 42-204, Idaho Code. Witness the signature of the Director, affixed at Boise, this 9th day of December, 2008.
