IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES
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Conditions of Approval:

1. T07 The right holder shall accomplish the change authorized by this transfer within five years of the date of this approval.
2. T08 Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of this transfer is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the transfer.
3. T19 Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as may be determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court at a point in time no later than the entry of the final unified decree.
4. 004 This right does not grant any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.
5. 046 Right holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Section 42-235, Idaho Code and applicable Well Construction Rules of the Department.
6. Prior to diversion and use of water under this right, the right holder shall install a flow measurement and volume totalizing device of a type approved by the Department on each point of diversion to measure flow and volume of water diverted.
7. 196 The right holder shall install or construct a straight length of conduit or ditch suitable for installation of a device for measuring the entire flow of water being diverted in connection with this right. If the right holder uses conduit, the straight length of conduit shall be at least fifteen times the diameter of the conduit and shall be above ground or otherwise easily accessible.
8. 020 The diversion and use of water described in Transfer 78356 may be subject to additional conditions and limitations agreed to by the protestant and the right holder under a separate agreement to which the Department is not a party. Because the Department is not a party, the Department is not responsible for enforcement of any aspect of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions herein. Enforcement of those portions of the agreement not specifically addressed in other conditions shall be the responsibility of the protestant and the water right holder.
9. Diversion and use of water in connection with this right is subject to a Monitoring-Reporting Plan. The right holder shall provide the Department with a plan for monitoring-reporting aquifer levels, diversion flow rates, and volumes. The monitoring-reporting should occur in parallel with land development and production and should include identification of non-production wells and timelines for measuring and reporting. The right holder shall not divert water in connection with this right until the plan is approved by the Department. Failure to comply with the plan once it is accepted shall be cause for the Department to cancel or revoke the right.
10. Water rights 61-12348, 61-12349, 61-12350, 61-12351, 61-12352 and 61-12353 shall be subordinated to 61-12090 in the event of priority administration of water rights with points of diversion within administrative Basin 61.
11. Water rights 61-12348, 61-12349, 61-12350, 61-12351, 61-12352 and 61-12353 shall be subordinated to 63-32499 in the event of priority administration of water rights with points of diversion within administrative Basin 63.
12. X27 This right is for an enlargement of 2.36 acres within the place of use described above.
13. C11 This water right is subordinate to all water rights with a priority date earlier than April 12, 1994, that are not decreed as enlargements pursuant to Section 42-1426, Idaho Code. As between water rights decreed as enlargements pursuant to Section 42-1426, Idaho Code, the earlier priority right is the superior right.
14. Rights 61-12351 and 61-12352 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.27 cfs, a total annual maximum diversion volume of 64.2 af at the field headgate, and the irrigation of 16.0 acres.

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15. Rights 61-12348, 61-12350, 61-12351 and 61-12352 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.41 cfs and the irrigation of 30.9 acres.
16. Rights 61-12349, 61-12350, 61-12351 and 61-12352 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.65 cfs, a total annual maximum diversion volume of 160 af at the field headgate, and the irrigation of 40.0 acres.
17. Rights 61-12348, 61-12349, 61-12350, 61-12351 and 61-12352 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.65 cfs, a total annual maximum diversion volume of 188 af at the field headgate, and the irrigation of 47.0 acres.
18. X35 Rights 61-12348, 61-12349, 61-12350, 61-12351, 61-12352 and 61-12353 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.94 cfs, a total annual maximum diversion volume of 249 af, a total annual maximum consumptive use volume of 184 af, and the irrigation of 62.3 acres in a single irrigation season.
19. R64 This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.
20. F06 The following rights are diverted through points of diversion described above:
61-12280, 61-12281, 61-12282, 61-12283, 61-12284, 61-12285, 61-12342, 61-12343,
61-12344, 61-12345, 61-12346, 61-12347, 61-12348, 61-12349, 61-12350, 61-12351,
61-12352, 61-12353, 61-12354, 61-12355, 61-12356, 61-12357, 61-12358, 61-12359.


