This office received your application on January 6, 2020. The application cannot be accepted into the records of the Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) until the following items are addressed:

- **4 - Point of Diversion**
 - The Point of Diversion was not marked on the map. Please indicate where the well is to be located and label accordingly, making sure it matches the description provided in item #4.
- **5 - Proposed Use**
 - Your application states that water from the proposed well will be used for dust control. If this is the case, a proposed use of "commercial" should be added to item #5. The rate that is requested for dust control will need to be justified for that use, but this justification is not required for the application to be accepted into the Departments records and establish a priority date.
- **9 - Place of Use**
 - The Place of Use description provided in item #9 does not match the provided map. A portion of the place of use towards the road in front of the house on the map crosses into the SENW QQ. Therefore, there needs to be some indication of this SENW QQ in the table under item #9, making sure that the description in item #9 matches the map.
- **13 - The Map**
 - The map needs to be modified to reflect the necessary amendments mentioned above in items 4 & 9. In addition, you may want to consider amending the place of use to include your entire parcel so that the dust control can be applied to your entire property if needed.
