

This map depicts the IRRIGATION place of use boundary for these water rights at the time of this approval and is attached to the approval document solely for illustrative purposes.



This map depicts the IRRIGATION place of use boundary for this water right at the time of this approval and is attached to the approval document solely for illustrative purposes.







Evaluation of Sufficiency of Information Submitted

Application for transfer proposes to change and/or add points of diversion (POD) to two ground water and three Silver Creek water rights with a combined flow rate of 5.47 cfs. The rights provide water for irrigation, stockwater, and domestic purposes. The Silver Creek rights will change and/or add existing PODs so that, as a result of the transfer, each right will have the same three PODs from Silver Creek. The three proposed PODs are located approximately 2.8 miles east and 2.2 to 3.2 miles south of Picabo.

Each ground water right will retain their existing points of diversion (wells) and points of injection into Silver Creek, but will add and/or change their points of re-diversion from the existing locations on Silver Creek to the three proposed Silver Creek PODs.

The transfer was advertised because it proposes to change points of diversion on surface water rights. No protests were filed. The transfer is located within Water District 37, so Watermaster comments were solicited. The Watermaster did not object to the transfer.

Two of the points of diversion/re-diversion will be moving upstream, though no other points of diversion are located between the PODs being moved and the proposed PODs. This section of Silver Creek, and sections downstream, are covered by minimum stream flow rights held by the State of Idaho, so the Planning section of IDWR will be solicited for comments. No comments were received from the Planning section.

Authority to File:

IDWR records show the water rights are in the name of the applicant, Renegade/McGlochlin, LLC. The application was signed by Diane Rinker, manager of Renegade/McGlochlin, LLC. The annual report form from the Idaho Secretary of State showing this is included with the application.

Water Right Validity:

Rights 37-2444, 37-7551, 37-464, 37-2188, and 37-12018 were all decreed in the SRBA in 2002, 2003, and 2006. Recent aerial imagery appears to show sufficient irrigation so forfeiture is likely not an issue.

Injury to Other Water Rights:

None anticipated or foreseen. Two of the Silver Creek points of diversion/re-diversion will be moving upstream, though no other points of diversion are located between the PODs being moved and the proposed PODs, so injury may not be an issue.

• Enlargement of Use:

None anticipated. This transfer is changing points of diversion only.

No issues anticipated. The application was advertised with no protests.
