RENTAL AGREEMENT CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
- 2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
- 4. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
- 5. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
- 6. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
- 7. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate authorization for the use of a water right based on a water right's priority date.
- 8. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
- 9. Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as may be determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court at a point in time no later than the entry of the final unified decree.
- 10. The right holder shall record the quantity of water diverted and annually report diversions of water and/or other pertinent hydrologic and system information as required by Section 42-701, Idaho Code.

- 11. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.0 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the lands above.
- 12. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.
- 13. A lockable device subject to the approval of the Department shall be maintained on the diverting works in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversion.
- 14. Use of water under this agreement will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 140.



The Department of Water Resources acknowledges receipt of your application to rent water from the Water Supply Bank. I have enclosed a Water Supply Bank Rental Agreement for your review and signature. Upon signature and return of the original agreement, together with the rental fee described below, the Department will also sign the original agreement and return an executed copy to you. Execution of the agreement and compliance with the conditions of approval authorize diversion and use of water as provided in the agreement.

Re: Water Supply Bank Rental Application 1614

Purpose/Narrative: An application was received December 19, 2019 requesting the rental of water right 45-13905 for a full five years. The applicant, Craig Searle on behalf of Moo View Cow Palace, is also the current owner of the water right which has been leased to the Bank from 2010 through the end of 2020.

Mr. Searle has requested to rent the full amount available of the right however, the lease contract is set to expire and the right will only be available for a single year. Mr. Searle was notified via email that the rental was only available using this right for a single year unless the lease application was renewed, otherwise the Bank would proceed with the single year rental. At the time of this review there has been no response, as such we will proceed with the rental for a single year.

Historically this right has been changed from an irrigation water right to a commercial water right for the construction of a dairy (transfer no. 71925). As the dairy has not been completed this right has not been used for commercial purposes and was accepted into the Bank as 0.3 cfs and 352 af for the irrigation of 88 acres.

After talking with Mr. Searle is appears that the dairy is not going to be built. He requested that we proceeded with the rental for a single year before the transfer is revoked and the rights are changed back to irrigation from commercial.

Authority to File: The applications were signed and submitted by Mr. Craig Searle, Idaho Secretary of State Records show that Mr. Searle is a general partner of the business. No concerns about the applicant's authority to file at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: This right is a split of 45-7186B and was initially leased to the Bank beginning in 2010 for an indefinite term. When the Bank initiated the five year time limit Mr. Searle requested that the term carry through the end of 2020. No concerns of validity at this time.

Injury Evaluation: The rental proposes to use the applicant's own water right, in full, at their own place of use. Mr. Searle had requested the rental through 2024 however, as the water right is only available through 2020 the term has been adjusted. It is unclear how the place of use will receive the irrigation as the identified points of diversion are two sections to the north. While the rental is within the ESPA, no modeling is required.

Enlargement of Use: No enlargement is evident through the rental as the amount available is reflective of the amount historically used for irrigation. The place of use intended to be irrigated is within the surface water delivery area of the Southwest Irrigation District however only the ground water will be used to cover the acreage. As such, conditions will be added to the agreement to limit water use and prevent the possibility of enlargement.

Local Public Interest: Staff are unaware of any local public interests that are averse to the

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The rental appears consistent with the conservation of water resources in Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Watermaster and IDWR Southern Region comments were requested January 29, 2020.

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Bank staff recommend the approval of this rental through 2020.

Morning!

I have started the review of your rental of water right 45-13905 and wanted to check in, from the application it looks like you are requesting a five year rental. At this time we can't do the full five years as the contract for lease for that water right is set to expire December 31, 2020. Since this is your own right we have a some options that may be helpful:

- 1. Execute the rental contract for a single year and send in your application to lease the water right in next year as a lease/rental package.
- 2. Hold the rental application so you can submit the lease application extending the period the water right is in the Bank. Then we can process the rental for the full five years through 2024.
- 3. Proceed with the five year rental and use the available rights leased to the Bank in your area. This may change the rental fees due as a rental of more acre-feet may be necessary as mitigation due to your proximity to the Eastern Snake Plane Aquifer. For more information on the ESPA <u>our page</u> has the model grid cells, modeling tool, and results analysis.

Since there is not an application fee for a rental the fastest option may be to process the rental for a single year, then send the lease/rental package together next year or, use the available rights in the area for the full five years. In your application you indicated that the latest start date is November 15, 2020 so if time is not a factor we may be able to process the lease/rental package this year before that date. If I don't hear back from you by Friday January 17, 2020 I will proceed with the rental for a single year so that you are covered for 2020.
