- 6. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT: This lease is between the Board and the Lessor, who is the recognized owner or designated representative of the recognized owners of water rights described herein. Should ownership of any part of a water right herein described change during the term of this lease, either through a water right split, a water right transfer, sale of property to which the water right is appurtenant, or through any other recognized water right reassignment, the lease benefits and obligations to the conditions of acceptance for any such water rights will be assigned to the new owners.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate.
- 2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.



 - a. Rental payments will go to the lessor(s) of record at the beginning of the rental season, even if the Department processes a Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership during the rental season.
 - b. New lessor(s) of record will receive payment for any subsequent rental seasons.
- 11. The water right(s) is leased to the bank subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
- 12. After specific notification by the Department, the right holder shall install a suitable measuring device or shall enter into an agreement with the Department to use power records to determine the amount of water diverted and shall annually report the information to the Department.

Description of Water Right and Lands That are Not Being Irrigated

In 2012 Idaho Power filed transfer number 77714 to create a common permissible place of use (PPU) and common points of diversion (PODs) for water right 2-39 and 2-40. These rights are used to irrigated Scout Park and North Park near Idaho Power's C. J. Strike Dam. The transfer was done because irrigated areas in both parks were recently changed and the establishment of a PPU allows for irrigation realignment if needed in the future. Water right 2-39 allows for the irrigation of 7.0 acres and water right 2-40 allows for the irrigation of 5.0 acres. The 12 acres of allowed irrigation can occur within a 20.3 acre PPU (Attachment 2).


Three maps are attached to this application. One map shows the permissible place of use and associated PODs for water rights 2-40 and 2-39. Maps for both Scout Park and North Park are also attached showing the acreage within the PPU that is not irrigated. The total PPU for water rights 2-40 and 2-39 is 20.3 acres. Currently, Idaho Power is irrigating 10.77 acres of the 20.3 PPU. In Scout Park, 3.45 acres remained unirrigated and in North Park 6.08 acres remain unirrigated. All areas not currently irrigated in the attached maps will remain unirrigated for the period of time water right 2-40 remains in the water bank. There is currently 1.2 acres of authorized irrigation under water right 2-40 that is not utilized within the PPU as designated by Transfer 77714. Idaho Power would like to place this 1.2 acres into the Idaho Water Resource Board water supply bank.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate.
- 2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.
- 3. While a right is in the bank, the lessor may not use the right without approval of the Department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-351 for illegal diversion and use of water and may include civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701B.
- 4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, the lease term expires, or upon request from the lessor to change the term of the lease, provided the Board approves the release. Unless approved by the Department, leased rights may not be immediately available for release
- 5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed.
- 6. Use of rights 2-39 and 2-40 are limited when combined to one or more of the following in accordance with the conditions of approval on the water rights: total combined diversion rate, annual diversion volume, and total acres authorized for irrigation.
- 7. Rental of water under this right is subject to the limitations and conditions of approval of the water right.

- 8. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.
- Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements

 not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other Department
- In accordance with Idaho Code §§ 42-248 and 42-1409(6), all owners of water rights are required to notify the Department of any changes in mailing address or change in ownership of all or part of a water right. Notice must be provided within 120 days of the change.
- 11. If a water right leased into the Water Supply Bank is sold or conveyed during the lease term, and if the leased right was rented, the rental proceeds will be disbursed in the following manner regardless of any arrangements between the buyer(s) and seller(s) to the contrary:
 - Rental payments will go to the lessor(s) of record at the beginning of the rental season.
 - b. If a change in ownership is processed by the Department during a rental season, rental payment will be made to the person or entity who is the lessor of record at the beginning of that rental season.
 - c. New lessor(s) of record will receive payment after the following rental season.
