

ADOPTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE USERS OF

Water District 65-A Annual Meeting March 1, 2010

Meeting called to order by Chairman Butch Biggers.

Minutes read and approved.

Harry McCaulou made a motion that the chairman remain the same as 2009. Vaughn Spiker seconded motion carried. Chairman will be Butch Biggers.

Vaughn Spiker made a motion that Janice Lane remain secretary and Dave Poole seconded , motion carried.

Harry McCaulou made motion that Credential Committe remain the same Eric Herr, and Vaughn Spiker, Mark John , Vaughn Spiker seconded the motion carried.

Paul Drake reported on the Meeting held at the Grove in Boise to make all streams Bull Trout Habitat. A Group called the Wild Life Rockies petitioned the Gov. and it was reported that this would only affect 12 family businesses. This totally not true. Sage Hen was built for irrigation and this decision would effect all water users. Paul encouraged all not water users to voice their opposition to this decision. Discussion followed:

Roy Moses ask Paul if he had a map of the area? Paul showed the map and Sage Hen was in the area and Squaw Creek. If this happens with the Endangered Species Act other items might be affected.

This started in 2006 and was reviewed in 2007 and 2008 and was to be reveiwed in 5 years and in 2009 was recommended to establish the habitat.

Roy ask if the Ditches should work together and hire a lawyer? Eric suggested that the Water Association is working on the Habitat recommendation with the Irrigators in mind. Eric suggested that if this happened that a fish ladder might be recommended. Property owners would be affected by not being able to raise crops without the water. and Property Values would go down.

Eric reported that water was turned down in July and shut off Oct. 10.

Eric ask if he would be Water Master next year. Dave Poole made a motion for Eric to be Water Master and Vaughn Spiker seconded.

Steve Lester, Water Resource Board, suggested that there be a minimum paid by each person in the District to help generate money for the budget.

Roy Moses made a motion that the budget be raised by 1/2. The addition of 1 1/2 times for each person on the Tax role. Next March the budget would be voted on whether to leave it at 1 1/2 or lower it back to 1.
