The budget was discussed and it was decided to cut the collection back to the 2009 budget.

A question was asked if and when, and who inspects Sage Hen Dam? Steve Lester reported it was inspected every 1-5 years. Roy suggested that this question and others about Squaw Creek Irrigation be addressed at the next meeting.

Steve Lester reported on changing a place of diversion. A question was asked if a water user could sell their water rights? Steve Lester suggested yes but the water rights stays with the property.

A question was ask about subdividing propertys non use where does the water right go. Water rights go with the property unless it held back legally by the land owner.

The election of the Advisory Committee was suggested to keep it the same Mark John, Vaughn Spiker, Chuck Mackensie and Jim Bier.

Eric Herr reported that it has changed as to the way the Moss killer is applied. If the killer can kill fish it cannot be used. If copper sulfate or Zylene is used and the directions are followed it should be allowed.

The next meeting will be the First Monday in March at 1 p.m.

Harry McCaulou made a motion that meeting close and Vaughn Spiker seconded. Motion carried.
