Dear Joan,

You may still petition IDWR to participate as an intervenor in the matter. Please reply with an expressed interest in doing that and I will share the sections of Idaho Code and Administrative Procedure rules to give some guidance. That said, I will not exclude your presence from the conference, but will require non-participation, even if asked a question the protestant or intervenor.

During our phone conversation we spoke about your portions of the water Wargi rights and where they are diverted. Our records identify the old pump on Dave Renberg's land as the diversion point for those water rights. If diversion has been made elsewhere then it is unauthorized and you are directed to stop using it until you file for a transfer to change the point of diversion and it is approved.

Hope this helps.
