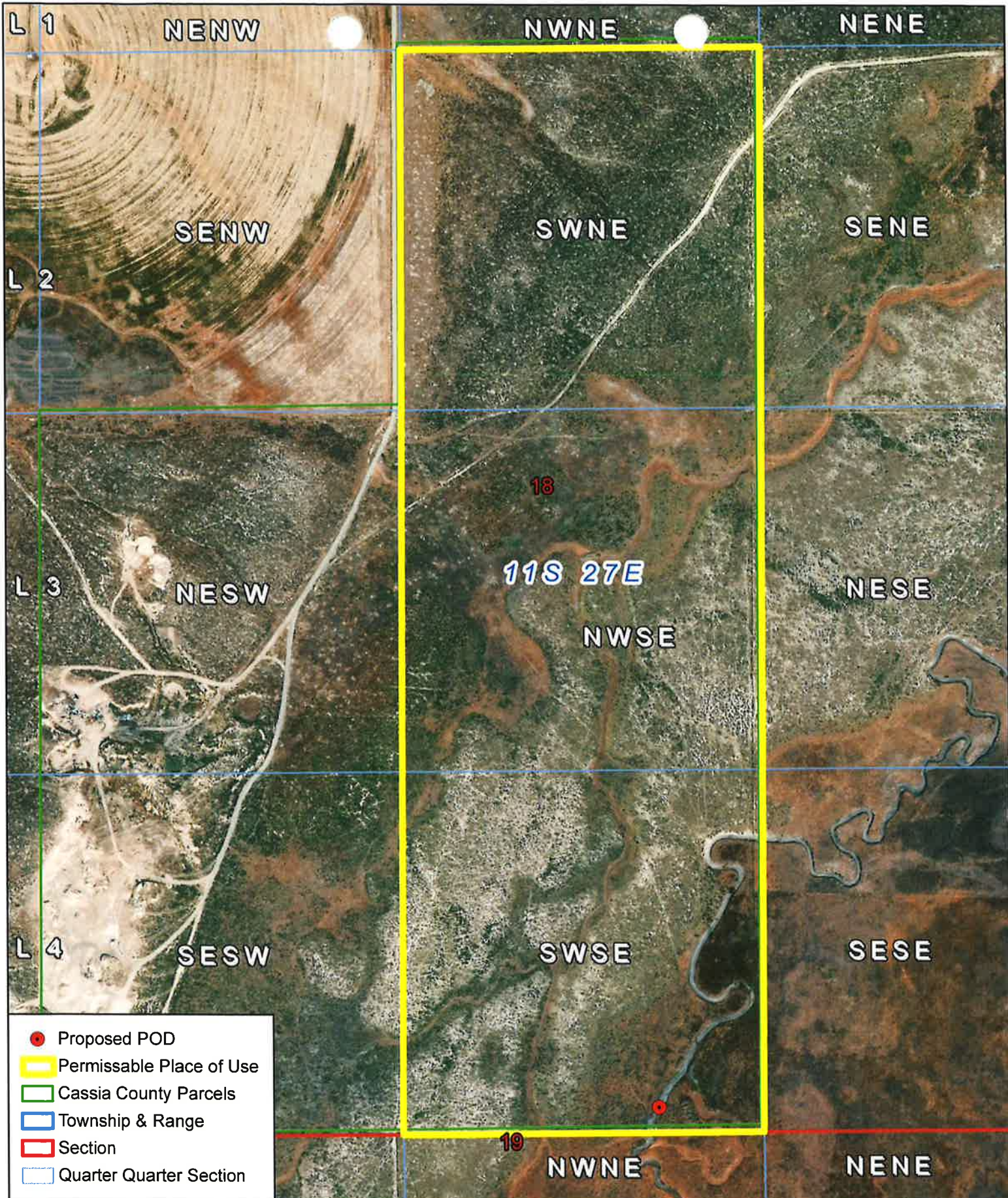
Narrative Proposal for New Water Right Application for Permit:

The applicants seeks a permit to divert water from Raft River for groundwater recharge. Existing recharge permits do not have capacity in the recharge facilities for flood flows of the Raft River. Diversion of flood flows for groundwater recharge effectively stores a portion of the flood volume in the Raft River Aquifer, a Critical Groundwater Area. Groundwater recharge during flooding also reduces flows proportionately to the capacity of the recharge facilities. The recharge location is beneficial for the applicant because it provides recharge upgradient of the applicant's farm and within the Raft River Critical Ground Water Area. The applicant's farming operation is within the northern portion of the aquifer where groundwater declines have been observed to be most significant in the basin.

The recharge facility will be adjacent to the Raft River in a natural basin. The applicant proposes a Permissible Place of Use (PPU) for recharge within the SWNE, NWSE, and SWSE quarter-quarters of Section 18, Township 11S., Range 27 E., which is adjacent to the Raft River on the applicant's property. The applicant proposes to recharge by diverting water from the Raft River into an old channel of that will flow into a recharge pond on the boarder of the SWNE and NWSE quarter-quarters. The Place of Use will include the old channel and the recharge basin. The Recharge pond will be built over a period of years until it is at the full capacity of the proposed permit. A Place of Use will be designated within the PPU for recharge at the end of the permit development period.

The proposed recharge facilities will be constructed to maximize recharge. Infiltration rates are expected to be high due to incident gravels and coarse materials. Fine grained soils and vegetation will be removed to access the underlying coarse material of gravel and sand. Recharge facilities will be maintained to remove fine sediments that may accumulate over time that could reduce the infiltration rate. Recharge rates are expected to be nearly instantaneous with no return flows and no storage.

Water will only be diverted when available and diversion will be coordinated with other permit holders within the basin. The diversion works will provide measurement of the diverted flow to the recharge facilities. Recharge is expected to occur within the old channel and recharge basin.
