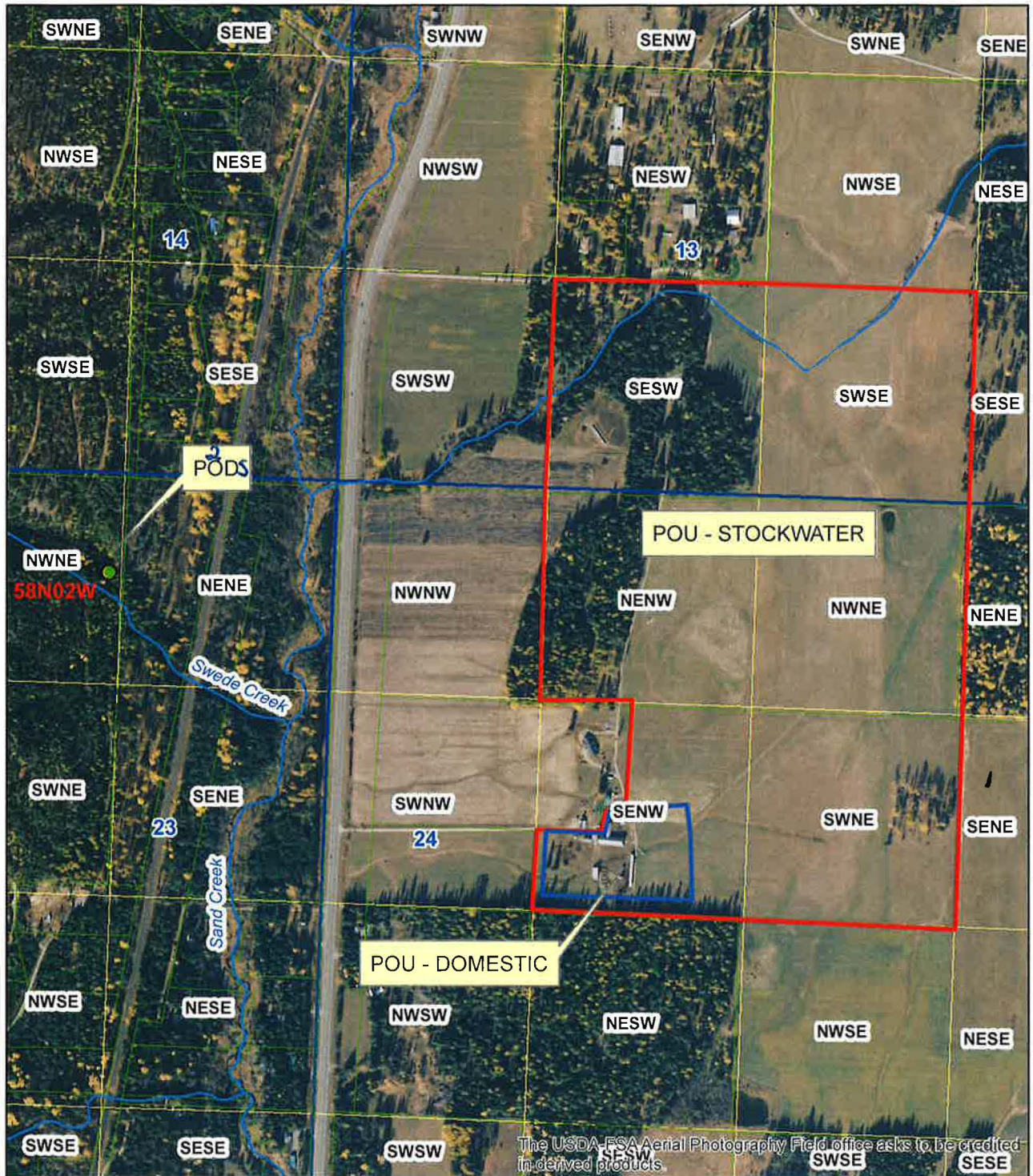

0 0.1 0.2 0.4 Miles

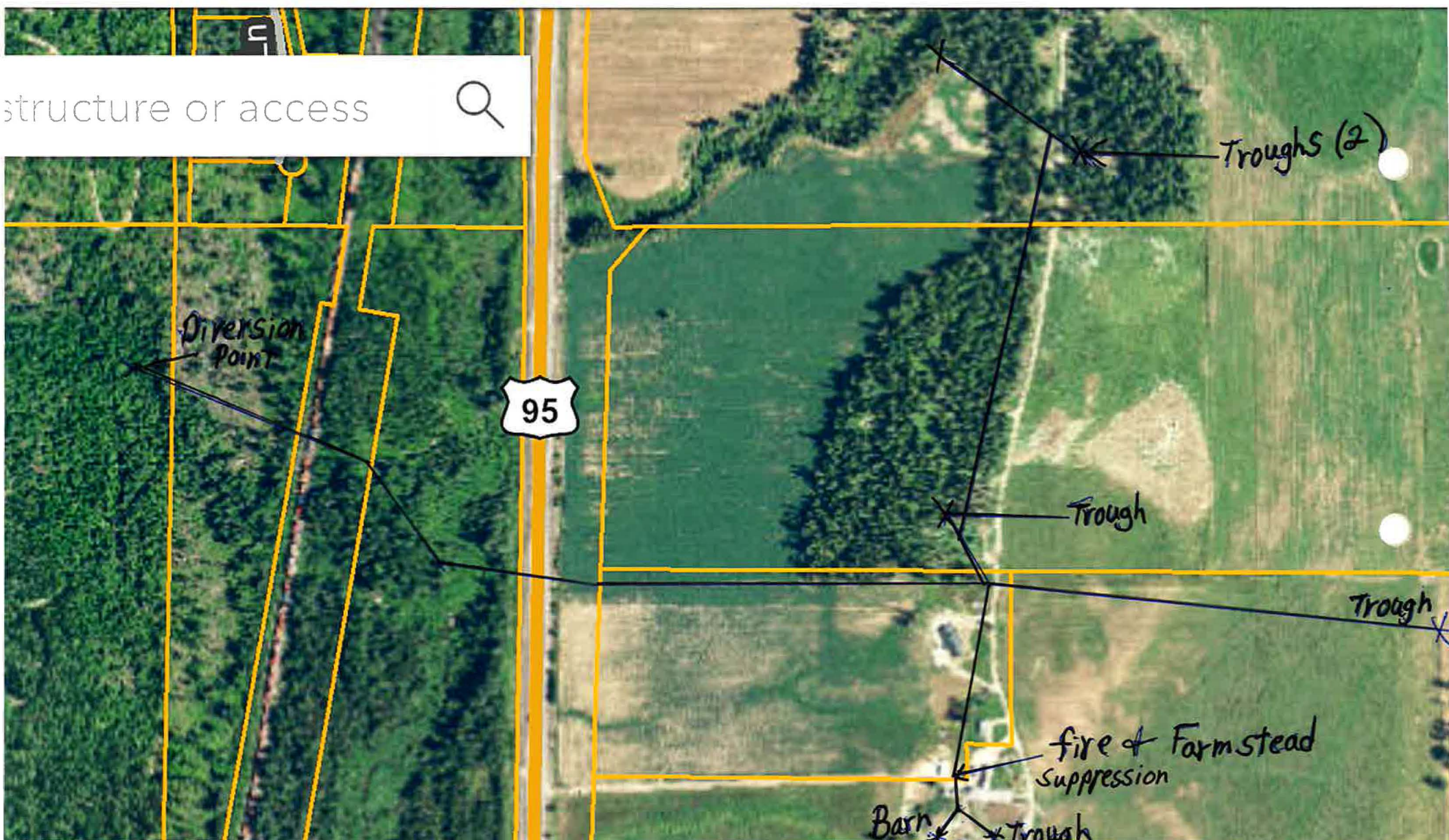


I propose to take on water at approximately 2200 FT elevation with a large gathering cistern type collection set up. Utilizing two, 6 inch perforated drain tiles approximately 12 ft long te-ed together and necked down to a 3-inch pipe. The 3-inch pipe will continue Eastwardly losing elevation onto our property and have a take off valve at The old farmstead on section 23, commonly known as the Elii place. The line will continue East entering the farmland on section 24. Then extending to the farmstead in the Southeast 1/4, of the Northwest 1/4 section 24. At this point the line will be tapped into by preexisting water lines of various sizes at farmstead and distribute water to stock-water tanks extending North 1/2 mile. It would also allow for water usage around farmstead area, irrigation on landscaping, and supply standby water for fire suppression.

Another main line will tee into the three inch line reduced to 1 1/2 inch and extend another half mile East to a proposed stock water facility to be utilized from several pastures and will facilitate live water for winter time usage as well as summer.
