Hello, Dave;

Thank you for your letter regarding the amount of my property that I have been irrigating up to now. when I moved here the irrigation was all flood irrigation. the location of my house made that impossible so the first two years I pumped water from the creek. My neighbor at the time suggested that I put in a pipe down the hill from the ditch, and I could sprinkle with gravity flow. The lower indian creek ditch is old and in poor shape. Every one who is on the ditch, except me, are absentee owners, so I am the only one who does any maintainence on the ditch. This year the ditch on my neighbors property was so overgrown with grass and weeds that I lost almost all of my water by mid july. One of the previous owners denied me access to the ditch with a backhoe, as a consiguince I had to hand dig approx. 300 feet of the ditch by hand.

All of my water comes through the pipe listed above. I water the area you show on the map as well as the area around my house. I also water under the trees to keep them green for possible fire retardation. We also have a garden that we irrigate out of the ditch, when we can get enough water, as it is now we do not. The area on the map that shows no irrigation, is an area that I cannot get gravity flow to reach. I am looking forward to having the new pipeline so I can effectively water all of my property to use my water right. Thank you for your letter regarding the amount of my property that I have irrigated up to now. The lower irrigation ditch on indian creek, is old and in poor shape. I am the only one on the ditch that lives here, and am the only one who does any maintaince on the ditch; For the last ten years I do not get enough water to irrigate as I would like to, All of my neighbors are absentee owners. A previous owner denied access to clean the ditch, I have hand dug the ditch three times, in the last ten years. At this point I have a two inch water pipe that I irrigate the pasture in the picture as well as some of the treed areas. I also water all around my house and garden. I also put water under some of the trees to keep them green. This pipe comes out of the ditch on the hill below the house that belongs to the Harringtons. The Pipe comes down the hill and through a culvert, all of the water I use comes through that pipe. Some of the area that is not irrigated on my property is because I cannot make it flow up hill. I am hoping to be able to irrigate all of my property with the pipeline, and looking forward to not having to do all the work on the ditch, and not getting any water late in the summer

Dear Roberta and Ronald:

I am in the process of reviewing your application for transfer to move the point of diversion for water right 75-14245. I need additional information to confirm how the water right has been put to use within the last five (5) years. Without additional information there is a risk of forfeiting a portion of your water right according to Idaho Code § 42-222(2).

Typically the Department can use aerial imagery to confirm the use of irrigation rights. Your water right authorizes the irrigation of 5.0 acres. With the available imagery I have not been able to verify the irrigation of the full 5.0 acres. Due to the limitations of the available satellite imagery, please provide any additional information you may have that can be used to demonstrate the extent of your water use as authorized by water right 75-14245.

The information you provide could include documentation or descriptions of what and how you have been irrigating, documentation of the use and/or the maintenance of the current irrigation system, photographs of the water use, and/or drawing the boundaries of what has been irrigated on the enclosed aerial photograph of your property. If the water right has not been used to its full extent, you may want to describe the circumstances that have limited your water use. You may also want to consider the exceptions or defenses to forfeiture as listed in Idaho Code § 42-223.

Within 30 days, please submit any additional information you believe the Department may need to verify your use of water right 75-14245 during the previous five (5) years. If the requested information is not provided within 30 days, the Department will continue with the review of your application for transfer as it stands, with the risk of forfeiting a portion of your water right.


