RE: Application for Permit 34-7464

Dear Applicant:

In March 1984, you filed Application 34-7464, seeking a permit to divert water from Thousand Springs Creek for the irrigation of 240 acres in Sections 27 and 28, T09N, R22E. The application states that you own the property at the proposed place of use. As I was recently reviewing pending application files, I discovered that you no longer own any of the land at the proposed place of use. Pursuant to Rule 40.05(e) of the Department's Water Appropriation Rules (IDAPA 37.03.08), an applicant can be required to submit copies of "deeds, leases, easements or applications for rights-of way" showing "a possessory interest in the lands necessary for all project facilities and the place of use."

An applicant has an ongoing duty to ensure that a pending application remains complete and viable. Part of that duty includes maintaining an ownership interest in the place of use described in the application.

It appears that you have sold the property described in Application 34-7464 and likely have no further interest in pursuing the application. This letter is intended to be a formal request for you to provide documents showing an ongoing possessory interest in the proposed place of use. Please provide these documents, if any exist, on or before November 12, 2019. If no documents are provided, the Department will take steps to void Application 34-7464. Of course, you are free to simply withdraw the application. This can be done by stating your intent to withdraw the application in a letter to the Department.
