On May 13, 2019, Jeffery V. Waite filed application for permit no. 75-14946 with the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department"). Protests against the application were filed by Savage Ranch Water Users Association and Charles Mualem.

On October 1, 2019, the Department conducted a pre-hearing conference in this matter. During the pre-hearing conference Jeffery V. Waite stated he no longer wanted to pursue his application for permit and that he would formally withdraw application for permit no. 75-14946.

On October 21, 2019, the Department sent Jeffery V. Waite a letter requesting that he contact the Department or submit the withdrawal of application for permit form. The letter required a response within thirty (30) days. A response to the letter was not received.

Pursuant to Rule 700 of the Department's Rules of Procedure (IDAPA 37.01.01), the presiding officer may serve notice of a proposed default order denying an application if an applicant fails to respond to a written information inquiry.

PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 700 of the Department's Rules of Procedure (IDAPA 37.01.01), the Department notifies Jeffery V. Waite that the following default order is proposed to be issued because of their failure to respond to a written information inquiry:

Jeffery V. Waite is in default and application for permit no. 75-14946 is **DENIED without prejudice**.
