

The Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) is currently reviewing the above referenced application for transfer to change water rights. After preliminary review of the application, some concerns were identified regarding enlargement, feasibility, total acreage etc. issues that may result from your proposed changes. The transfer application would be denied if processed as filed due to these concerns.

- 1. Enlargement of the groundwater rights is a concern because the Place of Use (POU) does not completely match surface water use. We could change the Point of Diversion's (POD) to list all wells, but would not change the POU to match the surface water rights for fear of enlargement to the groundwater rights.
- 2. Total acreage applied for on the transfer is a concern because the group of rights total 209 acres of irrigation when accounting for combined use limits. We can create a 1400+ acre Permissable Place of Use (PPU) but would require condition 206 that would force you to identify a 209 acre shape intended as the POU. Which leads to concern #3...
- 3. Hydrologically connected sources is a concern because distance between current groundwater POD's and proposed POD's is significant. As a result, we have concerns that all the POD's proposed will not be able to deliver water to the entire POU proposed.

You may wish to withdraw your application or amend it with an alternate proposal that will avoid enlargement, feasibility, and total acreage concerns. IDWR will hold further processing of your application to allow a withdrawal or amendment of the application or any other information you may wish to submit in support of your existing or amended proposal. If you would like to set up a meeting to visit our office and discuss these matters, feel free to contact me.

Please submit the requested information for application processing to continue. You may seek additional time to provide the information by making a written request to delay processing. Your written response including the requested information, or a request for more time to seek the information, must be received within the next thirty (30) days.
