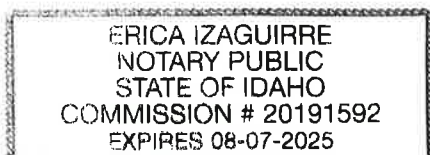

The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows: Application for transfer proposes adding seven existing wells to four municipal water rights (combined total of 21.28 cfs) to allow diversion for each water right from all of the seven wells. Place of use is the City of Twin Falls municipal water service area and all seven of the wells are located within the Twin Falls municipal water service area.
